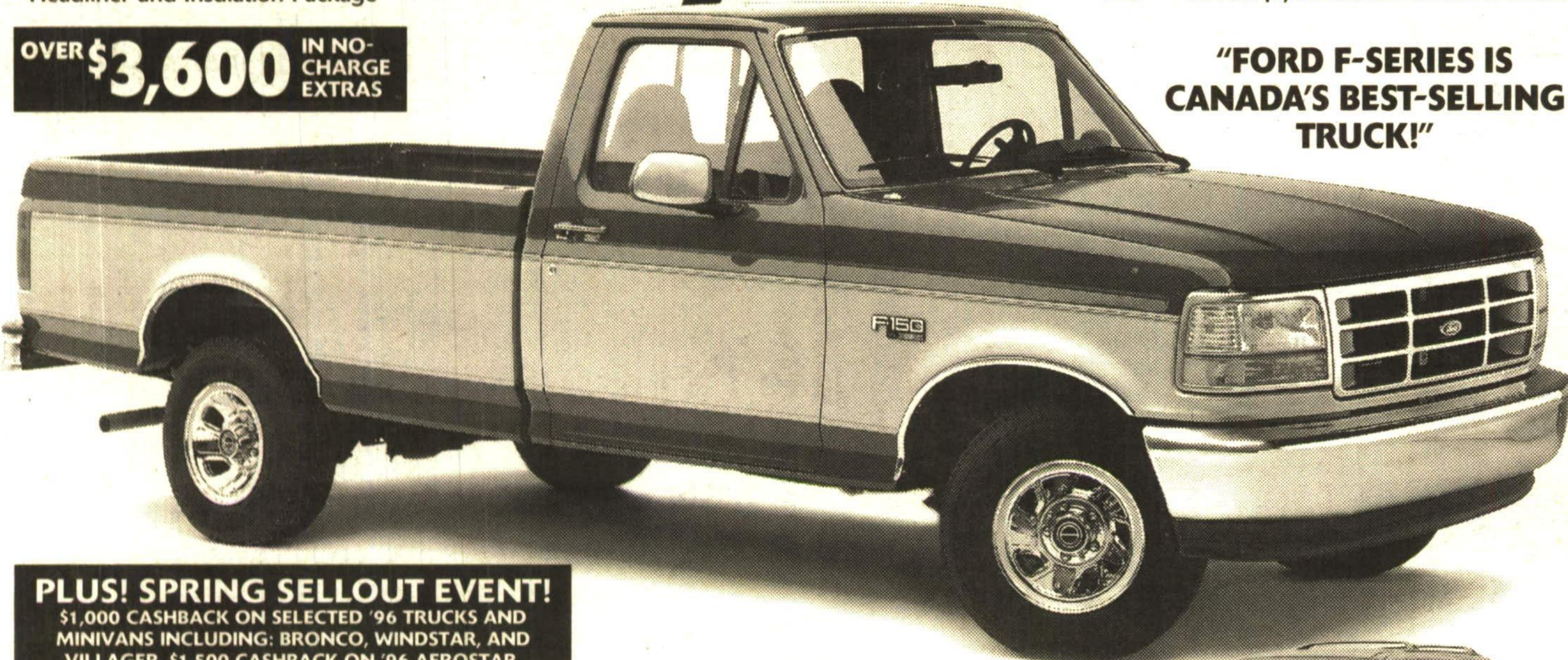

FOOD ALLERGIES MAY CAUSE EAR INFECTIONS!

Does your child suffer from frequent ear infections and you can't pinpoint the cause? It may be something he/she ate.
