#### INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Region of Peel will be rehabilitating the Terra Cotta Bridge, including complete deck replacement and removing and replacing the Leslie Bridge as shown on the attached plan. The work is required to maintain structure integrity at the Terra Cotta Bridge; the present condition of the existing Leslie Bridge warrants complete replacement.

#### SCHEDULE

A full road closure is required in order to facilitate construction. Road closure at the Terra Cotta Bridge is scheduled to commence on June 24, 1996, through to August 31, 1996. Construction on the Leslie Bridge is tentatively scheduled for the first part of July, 1996, and is expected to be completed within six weeks. Final restoration is expected to be completed by September, 1996.

#### **CONTACT PERSONS**




# TRAFFIC INTERRUPTIONS
