**Quick change scam**  
 Police are seeking a couple wanted for questioning in connection with a "quick change scam" in Acton.

According to 11 Division officers, a male, approximately 26, entered a gas station on Mill Street and asked to have some \$2, \$5 and a \$10 bill changed to \$20s.

The owner of the gas station recognized the scam and told an employee to get the license number of the Toyota Celica being operated by the culprit.

The suspect is described as a male, white, 183 cm (5' 10") tall. He dark hair "combed 50's style" with a dark shirt and brown checkered pants.

The man was accompanied by a female approximately 26 years and police say she may have claimed she was short-changed at a Queen Street, Acton variety store. The female claimed a clerk short-changed her and was given \$10 to make up the alleged oversight.
