#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- a) \*\*THIS YEAR WE ARE CHARGING \$40.00 PER FAMILY IN LIEU OF GATE FEES. IF YOUR FAMILY HAS MORE THAN ONE CHILD REGISTERING, YOU NEED ONLY SEND ONE CHEQUE FOR \$40.00.
- b) CHEQUES FOR REGISTRATION FEES MUST BE PROVIDED AS SPECIFIED ABOVE; CASH PAYMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- c) IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED REGISTERED, ALL THE INFORMATION REQUESTED ON THE REGISTRATION FORM MUST BE PROVIDED IN FULL; MEDICAL COMMENTS COULD BE USEFUL TO THE TRAINING STAFF IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION, SUCH AS ALLERGIES, ETC.
- d) CHILDREN WHO WISH TO TRY OUT FOR AMHA REP HOCKEY TEAMS MUST BE REGISTERED BEFORE THEY CAN BE ALLOWED ONTO THE ICE FOR TRYOUTS IN SEPTEMBER. CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT REGISTERED EITHER DUE TO INCOMPLETE INFORMATION OR NON PAYMENT OF FEES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE ICE UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THEY HAVE COMPLETED THE REGISTRATION PROCESS.
- e) ANY CHILD WHO DOES NOT MAKE A REP TEAM OR DECIDES TO RETURN TO HOUSE LEAGUE, WILL HAVE THE REGISTRATION FEES AND/OR POST DATED CHEQUES RETURNED IN FULL.

The AMHA sincerely hopes that these new measures will simplify the process, and make registration more convenient for the parents and guardians of our players.
