
#### Alarming costs


Earlier, council passed a resolution directing staff to investigate the feasibility of adding a clause to tender documents requiring the applicant certify it is environmentally friendly and has no financial interest in any company proposing a landfill in Halton Hills. Based on confidential legal advice

staff recommended the clause not be included.

### Bridge work

Town staff were directed June 17 to confirm the feasibility of installing the Hungry Hollow pedestrian bridge in Willow Park and include the appropriate funding in the 1997 capital budget. The bridge will be redundant in Hungry Hollow when the Mountainview Rd. bridge is completed and could be used to link Willow Park to Norval Park. The region has agreed to remove and transport the bridge and the Credit Valley Conservation has agreed the bridge can be stored at Willow Park until it's installed. Council has to approve the recommendation.
