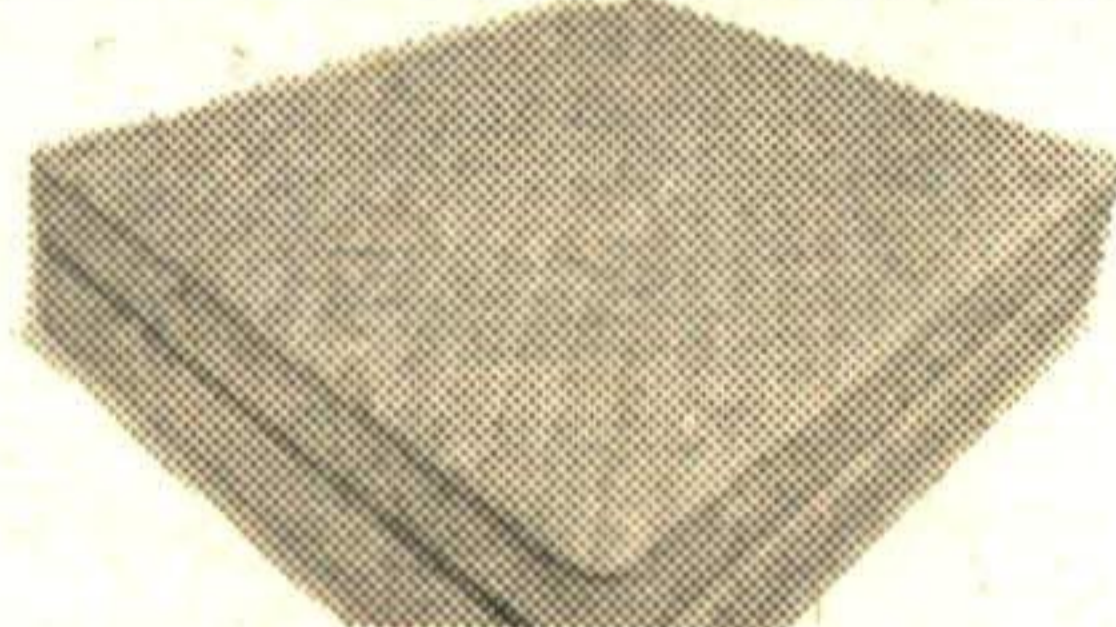

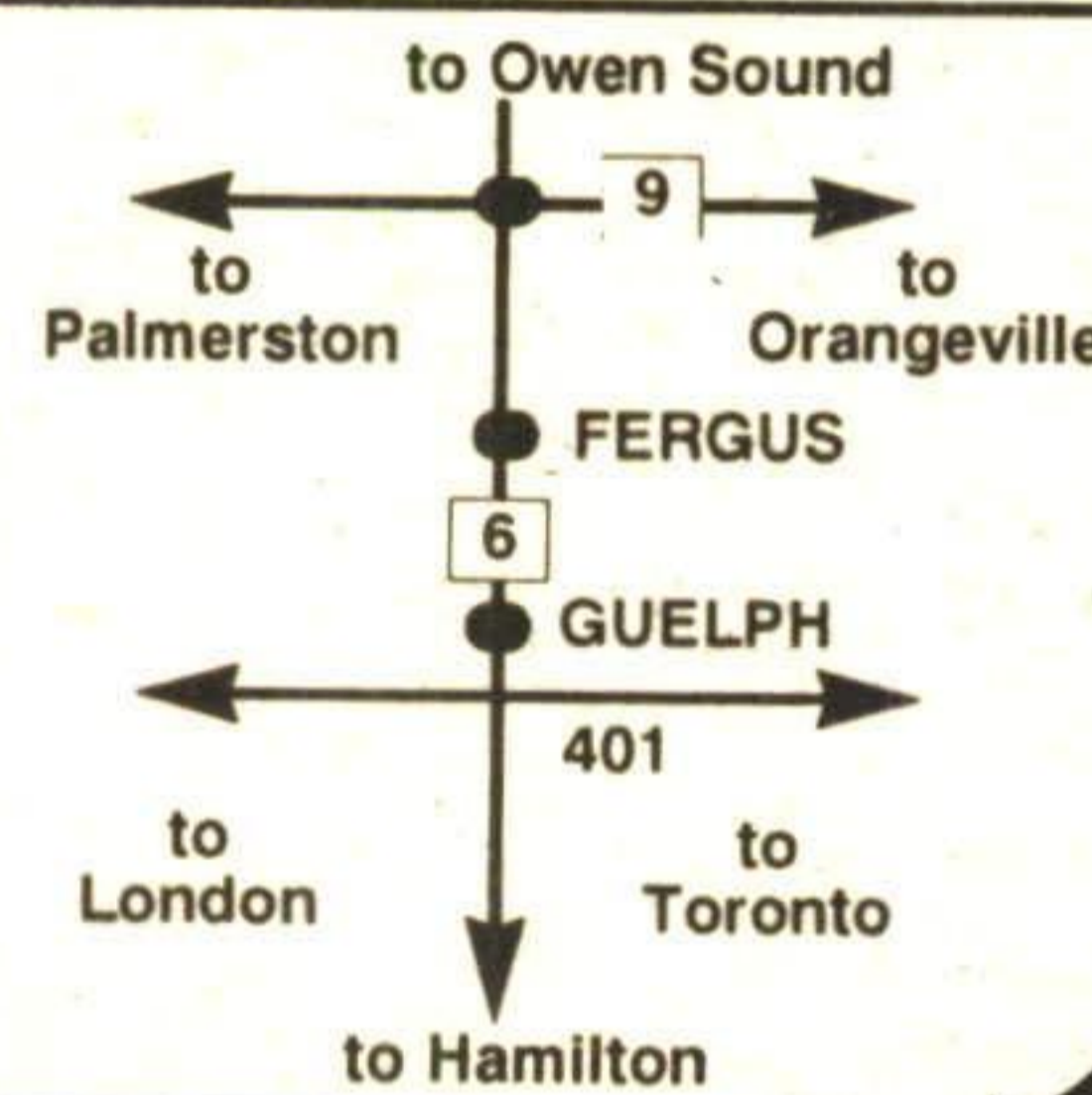

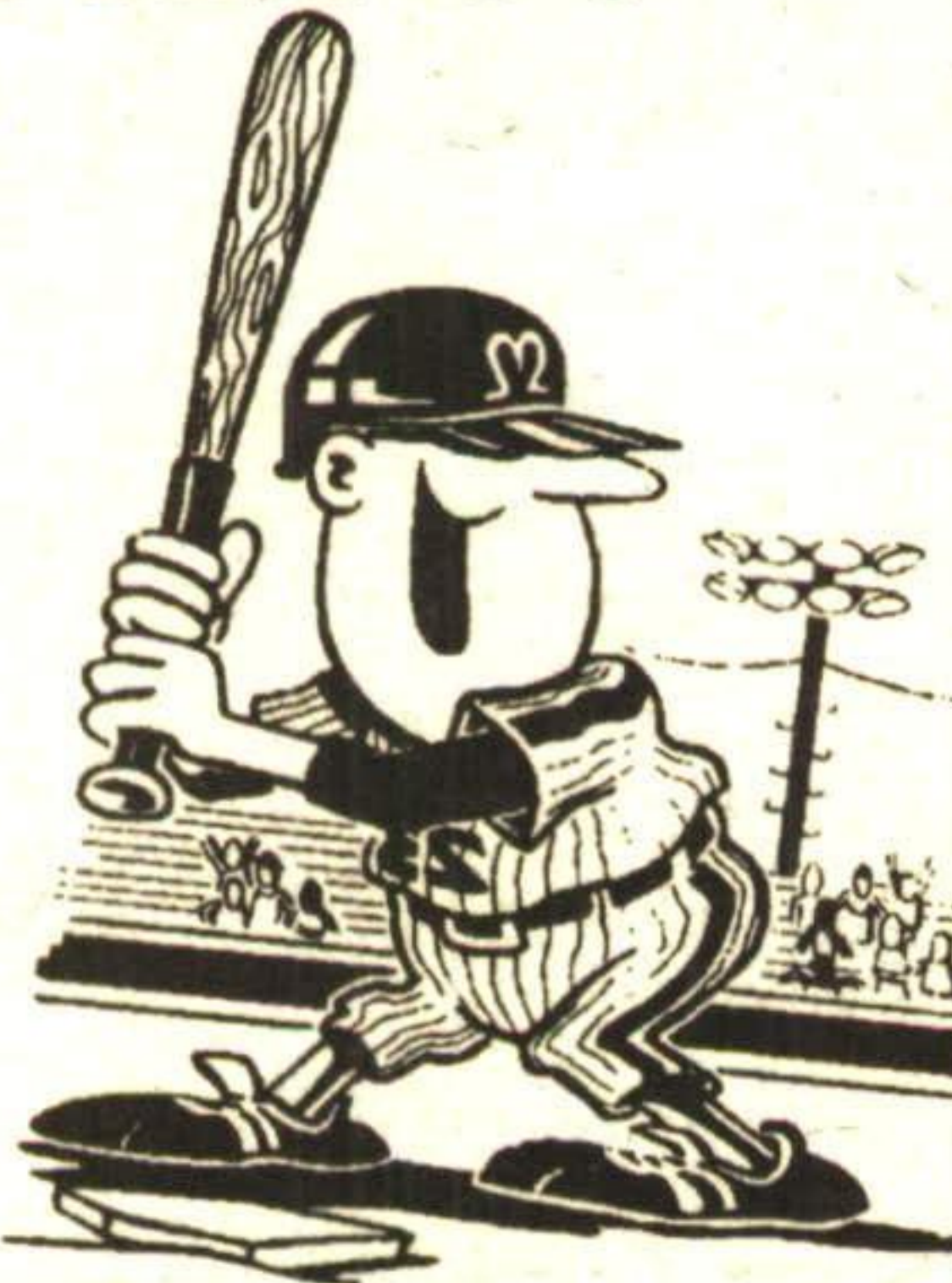

Last bell rings for 23

John Kavanagh was a Grade 6 and physical education teacher and had been with the Halton board for 31 years. Ivan MacLeod retired from the custodial staff.

Ian McGillivray, a business and math teacher at Acton District High School retired after being with the Halton Board for 32 years.

At Brookville School, John Lenz who had been on medical leave for a couple of years, is retiring after 25 to 30 years with the board. Betsy Wynen, a special education resource teacher, retired after 35 years service.

Former principal Gary Bateman who took medical leave earlier this year reports his health is better. He retired after 34 years with the Halton Board.

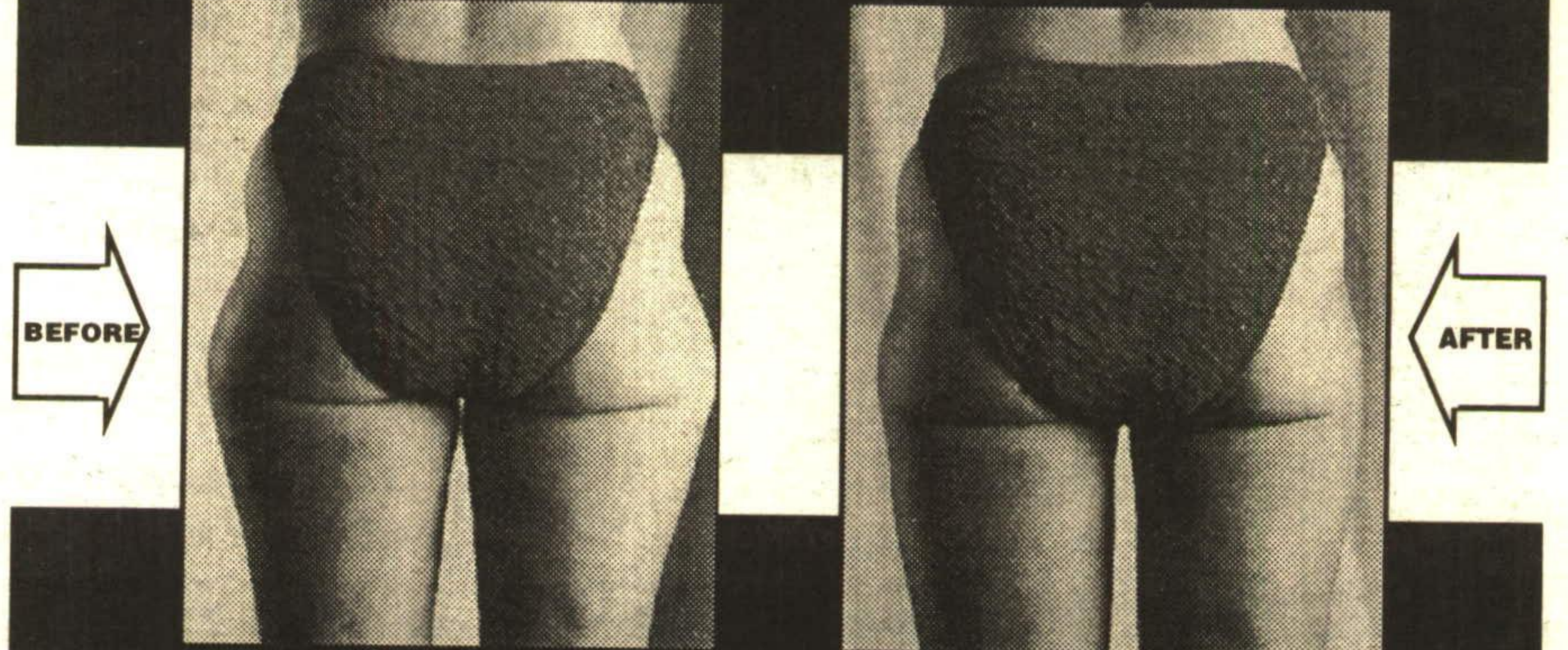
McKenzie-Smith Bennett vice-principal Larry Ciglen retired after 27 years.
