
TOWN HALL AT A GLANCE Lisa Tallyn

A series of burglaries in Acton has detectives seeking clues from the public that could point them in the direction of those responsible.


Between April 5 and May 6, four homes were entered in the developed area of Acton. Most of the houses had been left by their owners with a door

left unlocked, and most occurred during daytime hours.


The property stolen by the culprit has included cash, credit cards and


