


'Hank Williams' show comes to the JET, July 13

Georgetown to play the Llead in Hank Williams: The Show He Never Gave.

On July 13, 8 p.m., in the John Elliott Theatre, Reno will bring his life experience to the stage as the star of this Canadian piece written by Maynard Collins. Tickets can be purchased for \$17.

Reno turned down the chance to play the same lead in Toronto several years ago because, he says, he was living a similar lifestyle to the one portrayed in Hank's music.

"He (Hank Williams) sang and

talked about a lot I've experienced. I didn't lose myself in the bottle the way he did but I was borderline a few times. He went over the edge. I didn't," said Reno.

The concert/cabaret show is a flashback in 29-year-old Williams's mind before the tragic New Year's Day in 1953, when he died in the back seat of his Cadillac on the way to a concert. Reliving moments of his life, perhaps remembering them as they might have been, Williams justifies his life through his music. The play is based on the author's perception that the songs of the late singer were in reality prayers to a God he searched for all his life.




