**THE OLYMPICS**

With all the excitement surrounding the Olympics in Atlanta, Georgia, it's hard to believe that the Games got their start as a simple footrace. The first Olympic Games began in Greece in 776 B.C., and were held every four years for over a thousand years, until 393 A.D.

The modern Olympics began in 1896, again in Greece. In attendance were 311 athletes from 13 countries. Contests were held in nine sports: cycling, fencing, gymnastics, swimming, tennis, track and field, wrestling, weight lifting and shooting.

- 1896 First modern Olympics held in Athens, Greece.
- 1900 Women compete for the first time.
- 1920 Olympic flag introduced.
- 1924 First winter Olympics.
- 1928 Olympic flame introduced.
- 1992 At the games in Barcelona, Spain, 10,000 athletes from 172 countries compete in 257 events.
- 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta, Georgia.
- 1998 Winter Olympics in Nagano, Japan.
- 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia.

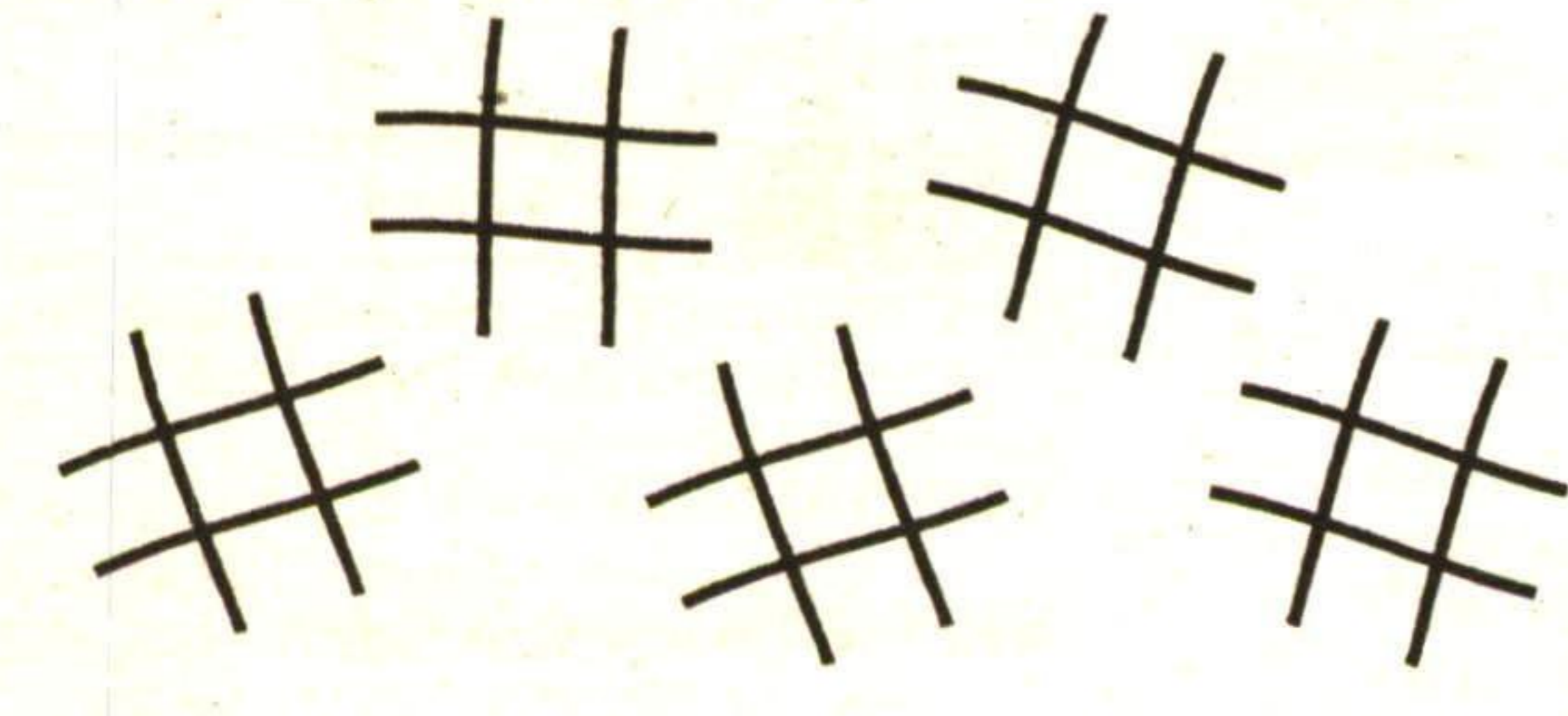

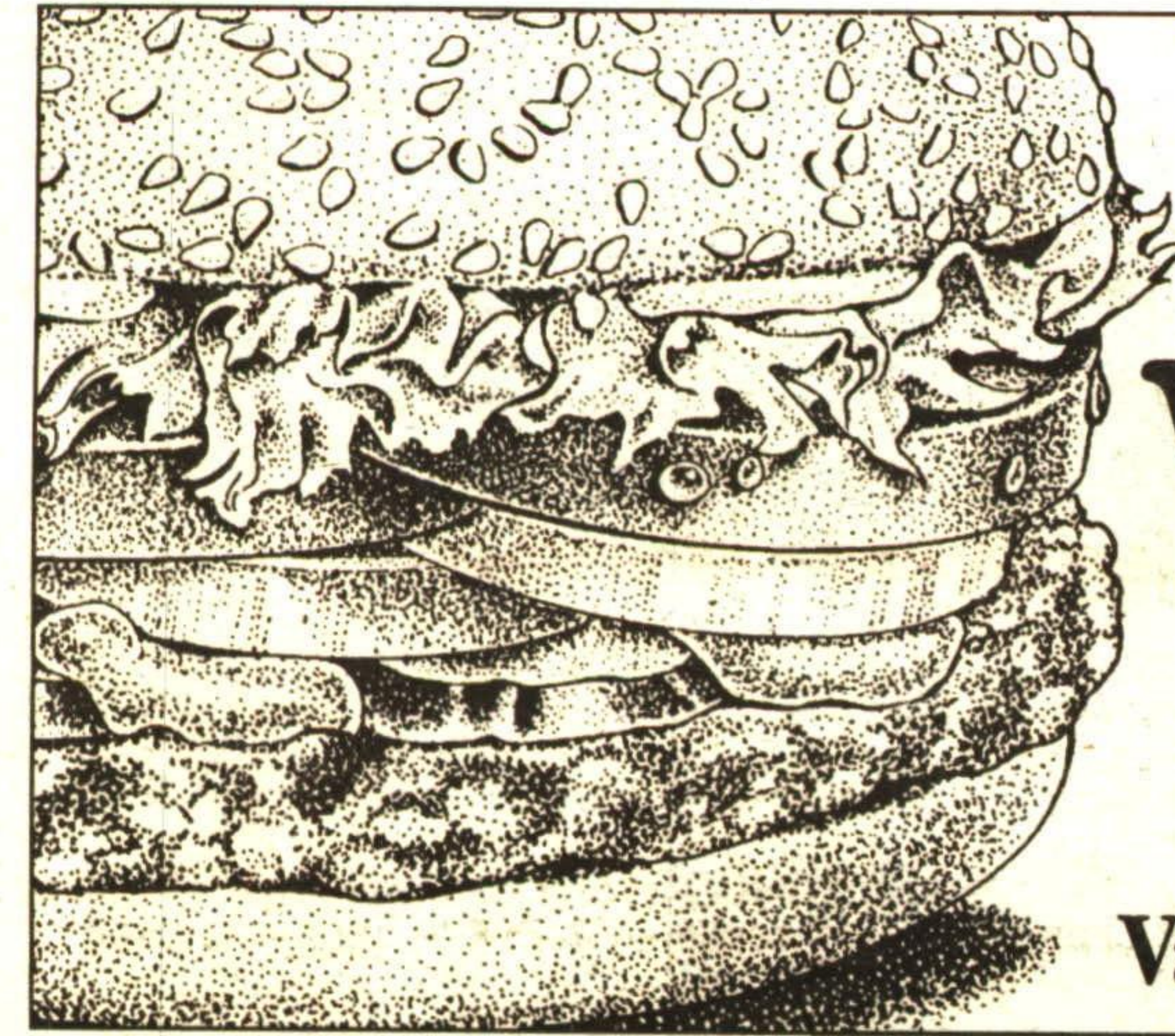
