## THEOLYMPICS

With all the excitement surrounding the Olympics in Atlanta, Georgia, it's hard to believe that the Games got their start as a simple footrace. The first Olympic Games began in Greece in 776 B.C., and were held every four years for over a thousand years, until 393 A.D.

The modern Olympics began in 1896, again in Greece. In attendence were 311 athletes from 13 countries. Contests were held in nine sports: cycling, fencing, gymnastics, swimming, tennis, track and field, wrestling, weight lifting and shooting.






