

# Profits from Pampered Chef kitchen show will be donated to UNICEF campaign

UNICEF will be the recipient of any profits made at a kitchen show at St. Andrew's United Church in Georgetown Wednesday, Oct. 16 at 7:30 p.m.

Everyone is invited to attend the show which is being put on by The Pampered Chef, a direct sales company specializing in quality kitchen products, time saving techniques and recipes.

Kitchen consultant Elizabeth Kerr will demonstrate the products by actually using them to prepare time-saving recipes. Wednesday

evening she will make a gingerbread house from a kit the company carries.

Profits made that evening will be donated to UNICEF along with \$4 for each show booked through the event.

Lesley-Anne Banks, coordinator of the Georgetown UNICEF campaign, said money raised by UNICEF provides the bare essentials such as health care, food, education tools and shelter for residents of Third World countries.

Banks said October is the month devoted to collecting for UNICEF and, as in the past, many area school

children will be bringing UNICEF boxes with them when they go trick or treating on Halloween.

Even a small donation can make a difference according to Banks.

She said 50 cents will buy oral rehydration salts for a child, 96 cents will buy 24 pencils for a classroom, 32 cents will purchase a vial of penicillin and \$1 will buy three packs of seeds.
