

Local choir auditions for Joseph show

On the heels of an appearance in a national bank commercial, some members of the Georgetown Children's Chorus are auditioning to be choir members in the upcoming production of Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat in Toronto.

Lois Fraser, administrator of the Children's Chorus, said 23 kids in the choir are auditioning for the role of choir members in

the show, which begins a 13-week run at the Elgin Theatre in March. Fraser said it was difficult to select only 23 choir members, but the kids had to be aged between 9 and 15 years old, and couldn't be taller than 5'6".

"The kids are really keen," said Fraser. "It was really difficult to choose."

They have to submit a tape of two songs by November 29 and should hear by mid-December if they have been selected to continue in the next round of auditions.

Fraser said 100 choirs

participated for the four spots when the show was last in Toronto.

If the Georgetown choir members are selected to perform they will appear in the show with Donny Osmond, who plays Joseph, and would have to take a month off school to rehearse. They would appear in four shows a week and each person would receive \$50 a week.

Fraser said the kids are already adding up the money which they can put toward the choir's upcoming trip to Holland.

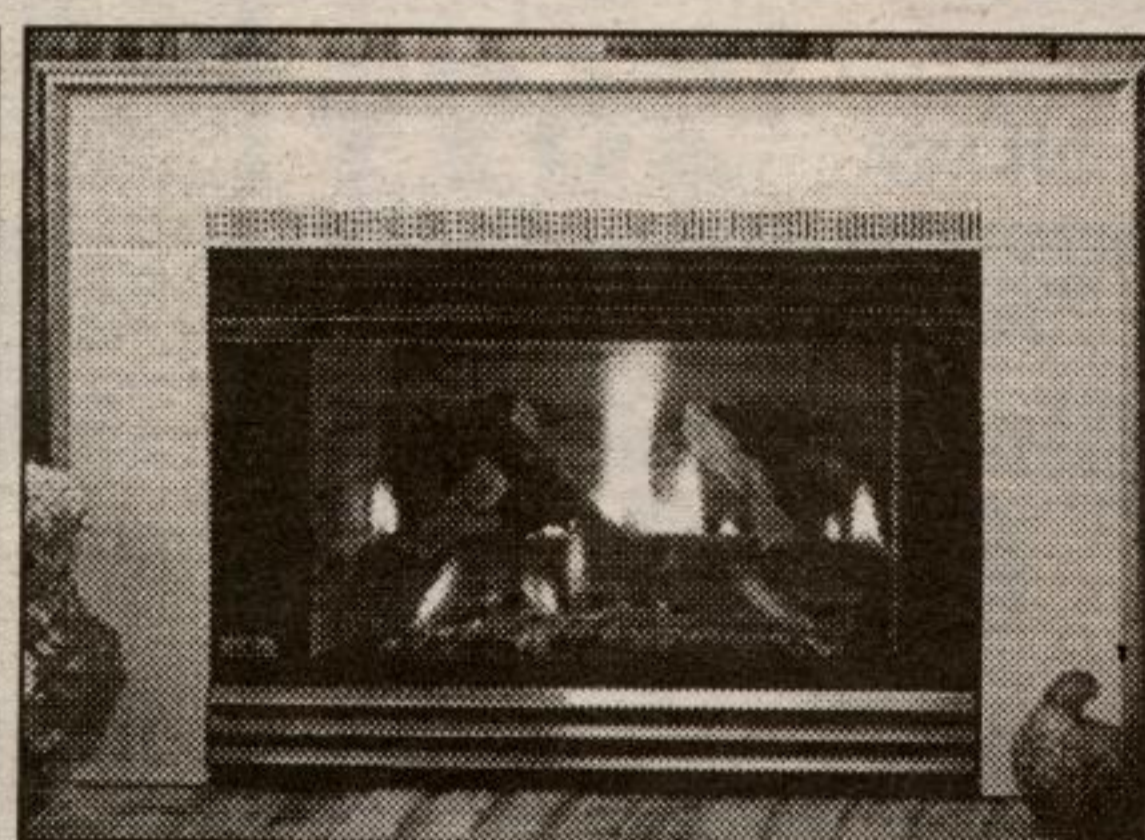
