Packing Pointers

Pack your current phone book to take with you.

It's quick, easy reference to the folks and businesses back home.

Place pictures in boxes between sheets and blankets to give them extra protection

Pack plates and record albums vertically on end, rather than placed flat and stacked.

Pack heavy items in small boxes, light items in larger boxes.

Tag each box with its destination room and contents for easy organizing upon delivery

Kid's Stuff

Have children write their name and new address on the boxes from their rooms. It'll help them remember their new address and help you distinguish the

kids' belonging from your own.

At your new home, hook up the TV first to keep the kids occupied during the rest of their move.

A Smooth Move

Make a note of your shipment registration number and keep it with you at all timew. Your mover will need this number if you call with questions about your shipment.

Give your van operator a phone number where you can be reached while your belongings are in transit.

If Your're planning on storing some of your goods, take time to tour the warehouse of the mover you're planning to use. Look for cleanliness, organization and adequate security.
