Timber-frame homes blend the past with the present

A timber-frame home is an intriguing mix of ancient self-supporting structures (timbers) and modern technology (interlocking stress-skin panels).

It is energy-efficient, comfortable, spacious and beautiful. The frame is exposed internally and can be integrated with the aesthetic and practical requirements of the home. Stress skin paneling, lighting, wiring and plumbing fixtures must be compatible. Elegant finishing touches such as eave and cornice treatments add to the beauty.

Simple, classic architecture yields exciting living space having universal and enduring appeal. Values and standards set centuries ago are cherished and nurtured. The network of posts and beams form a stucture that is rigid and self-supporting resulting in a feeling of spaciousness. Exposing the framework of the timber structure to the interior lends a feeling of security and balance.

Architects have long understood that a pleasing sense of structure can be an important ingredient in design. Beamed ceilings provide an air of strength as well as visual interest. Glass and timber can complement each other.

Timber-frame homes adapt well to modern technology. The most important asset of the timber-frame structure to

modern technology is the framework it provides for an extremely effective and completely separate insulation system.

With the frame bearing all the building loads, the insulation can be completely separate. This has the benefit of minimizing thermal breaks and simplifying construction. The stress-skin panel is a sandwich of interior and exterior sheathing with a core of rigid foam insulation. Using this technology the timbers are wrapped in an unbroken insulation layer, achieving the same energy performance as a super-insulated framed house.

Windows are cut out of the stress-skin panels after the panels are installed.

Timber-frame homes take more time to build than conventional homes, principally because more detailed plans are needed. Building inspectors have a tendency to want to see more on paper. Trades people need more drawings to define procedure and to interface with materials.

The exterior can be finished with any siding, such as cedar, brick, stone, etc., or any combination of these materials.

Uncompromized standards of workmanship and engineering allow timber-frame buildings to stand for centuries.




