

Guides and scouts to conduct door to door food drive Dec. 7

On Saturday, Dec. 7, the Guides and Scouts of Georgetown, Ashgrove, Hornby and Glen Williams will be conducting a "door to door" food bank drive to help stock the Bread Basket food bank in Georgetown.

This blitz starts at 9 a.m. and continues until 2 p.m. Special grocery bags have been donated and will be distributed by The Independent & Free Press in the Georgetown area only.

Apartment tenants who wish to donate should contact their building managers in order to co-ordinate the building pickup. Anyone who is missed and wishes to donate can phone the food bank at 873-3368 in Georgetown.

Some of the most needed food items are baby food, baby cereals, formula, peanut butter, macaroni and cheese, breakfast cereals, pasta, rice,

spaghetti sauce, tuna, canned hams and meat, canned fruits, vegetables and soups, sugar, fruit juices and powdered milk.

This year the Georgetown drop-off location is the Georgetown Terminal Warehouse, located at 34 Armstrong Ave. (next to Wastewise).

As well, Mold-Masters Limited is dedicated to helping the local families who require assistance, and are again challenging local companies to donate generously to the food bank. Last year, this food drive collected 8,425 pounds of food.

The new food bank, the Bread Basket, at 247 Armstrong Avenue, Unit 9 is open every Saturday from 10 a.m. to 12 noon.

Plan for Gardens lands to include school

accommodate the expected 1,000 to 1,500 students. Milton trustee Joseph Deoni, representing the school board at Thursday's meeting, said the board is willing to work with the town on the building's design, as well as sharing facilities. The school will probably not be built until 2004.

In the southeast corner, beside McDonald's, there will be at least 7 acres of retail including a 30,000 sq. ft. grocery store. Halton Hills IGA, across the street, will move into the new space.

On the Maple Ave. and Mount-

ainview Rd. side of the triangular-shaped property will be townhomes and three apartment buildings, totalling 550 units. The buildings in order to accommodate the required number of housing units may have to be 10 storeys in height, which had some councillors cringing.

However, specifics will not be known until the urban design guideline and subdivision application process which is the next step for the developer. It was also pointed out that servicing for the residential area is unlikely before the fall of 1997.

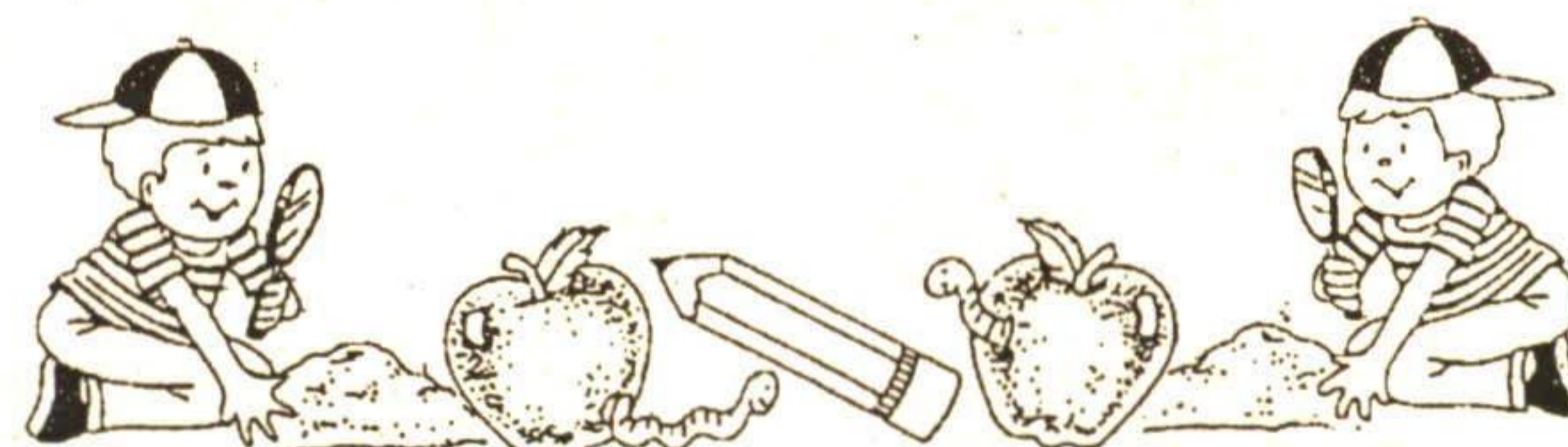
