It causes mental and physical impairment, stillbirth, goiter and cretinism in infants born to iodine-deficient mothers. Yet the solution is simple and has been available since the 1920's. Iodization of salt at pennies per person not only can prevent these disorders but reverse some existing conditions, as well, as improve mental capabilities and productivity in iodine-deficient populations.
