TEAC focuses on Hungry Hollow

Georgetown residents know a bit about Hungry Hollow along Silver Creek, the natural area in the southern part of town extending from the Eighth Line east to the Credit River in Norval.

However, there are hurdles to designating a natural area.

Rare wildlife species inhabit the area include Black Walnut trees and a small fish called the Redside Dace. Hungry Hollow is classified an Environmentally Significant Area (ESA) by Credit Valley Conservation and a Class 2 Provincially Significant Wetland.

Additional possibilities being investigated include an amendment to the town's Official Plan designating the land use as a "Special Policy Area", or the use of voluntary Heritage Conservation Easements as has been done in some areas along the Niagara Escarpment.

To protect Hungry Hollow, the Town Environmental Advisory Committee of Halton Hills, or TEAC, wants to propose the area for Natural Heritage Area designation. This designation is commonly given to an area or a structure which has been built by humankind, which merits this designation. Glen Williams is a local example of a designated area.

A management plan for Hungry Hollow will be prepared after council direction is established. The plan will ensure that parts of Hungry Hollow are made accessible for people to use while areas needing greater protection are left alone or possibly even rehabilitated.

GOVERNMENT SPONSORED TRAINING

UNEMPLOYED? If you are out of work and need to improve your skills, these programs may be for you.

Comprehensive Hydraulic Training - 27 weeks
Start/End Date: January 6 to July 11, '97
Prerequisites: Minimum of Grade 10 (OSSD transcript) or Level 3 B.T.S.D. math, English, and a mechanical aptitude. Mature student testing available. Interview with the program coordinator is required.

Robotics for Industrial Controllers - 20 weeks

Prerequisites: Testing is required for Grade 8 or equivalent math, English, and a mechanical aptitude.

Truck Driver A-Z - 6 weeks
Start/End Date: February 17 to March 28, '97
Prerequisites: Minimum of Grade 8 or equivalent, with the ability to read and write using the English language (testing may be required); valid Ontario Driver's Licence (Class "G" or better), and preferably able to drive a standard shift vehicle.
Location: Milton

Cost for the above programs: No cost to you if you qualify for sponsored training; eligibility determined by Human Resources Development Canada.

Eligibility Requirements: A Canadian Citizen or permanent resident; at least 17 years of age, and out of the regular school system for 12 consecutive months since turning 16 years of age; Unemployed, currently receiving Employment Insurance (formerly UI benefits) or those who received UI benefits within the last three years (five years in the case of maternity or parental leave).
