Detectives describe murder as 'execution-style'

Peel police homicide detectives aren't saying much about the execution-style murder of a Norval man last week.

There have been very few calls from the public offering any information about the December 11 killing of Gurdev Singh Ajula, 39, of Norval, but police are hoping to hear more from anyone who may have seen or heard anything in the area of Clarence St. and Rutherford Rd. the night of the murder.

Ajula was found dead in his Clarence St. truck repair shop at approximately 10:15 p.m. Police say the killer or killers had a 10-minute "window of opportunity" in which to murder Ajula.

They say they believe the murderer struck between 10 p.m. and 10:10 p.m. They say the killing was well-planned and they believe the victim had been watched.

Ajula owned A-Call Express Courier and A-Call Express Truck Repair, two businesses he operated since 1985 in Mississauga. He moved both businesses to an empty building on the corner of

Clarence and Rutherford only three or four weeks before he was killed.

Although the killing happened in an industrial area, investigators say they are not issuing any alerts looking for suspect vehicles.

Det. Sgt. Len Favreau says there are 15 full-time detectives working on the case, but he will say little else about what they have discovered during their investigation.

"We're still looking at all possibilities," he said when asked if Ajula knew his killer.

He refused to speculate if one or more people may have been involved, or what the motive was.

Ajula was married with a young daughter. Sources say he was involved in one or more civil suits at the time of his murder.




