PEP earns conservation award

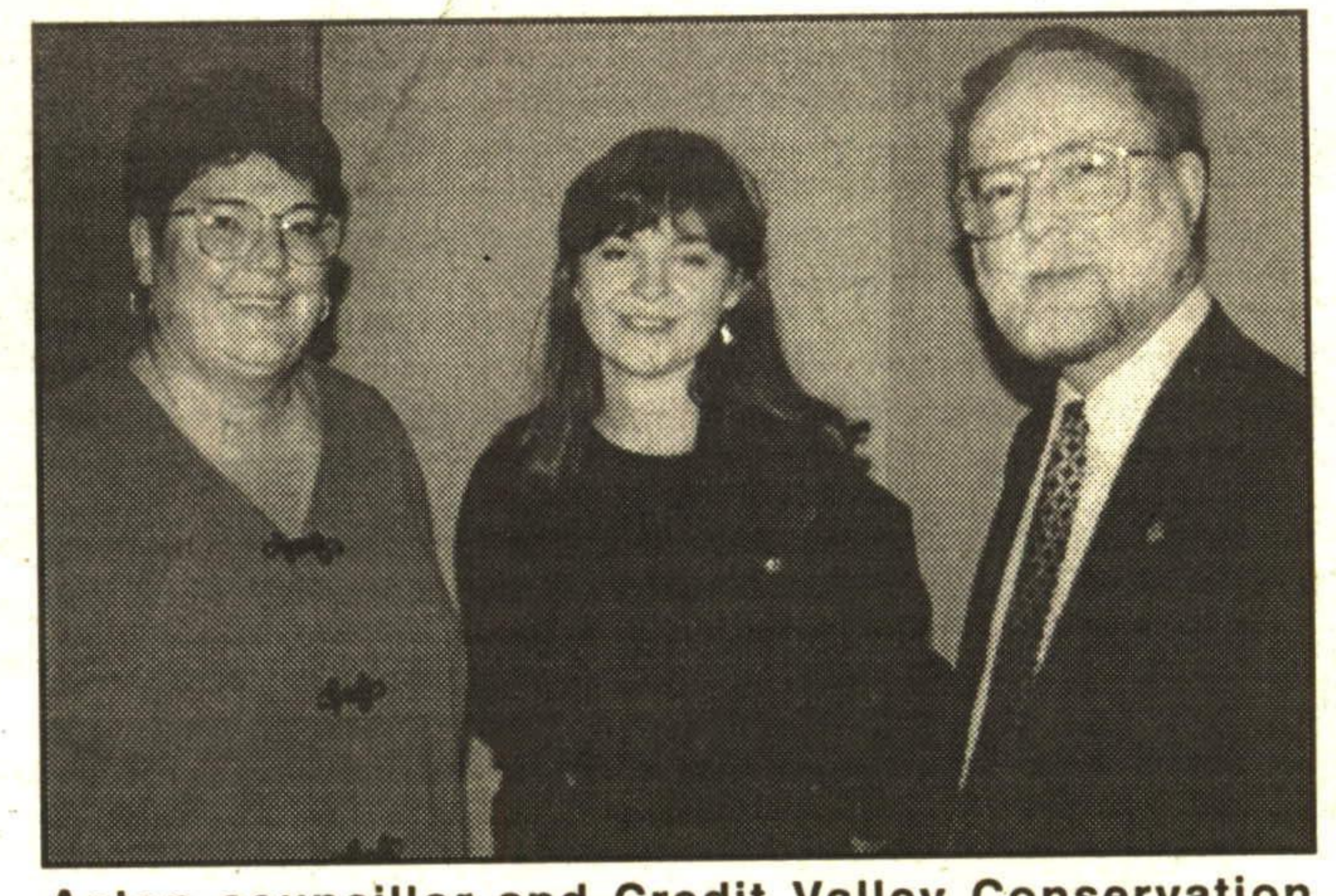
An Acton parent school council has received the conservation award for its participation in an environmental program.
