A very well-attended meeting was held on March 20 with a donation from the Ladies Auxiliary to the Talking Books for the Blind fund being the highlight.

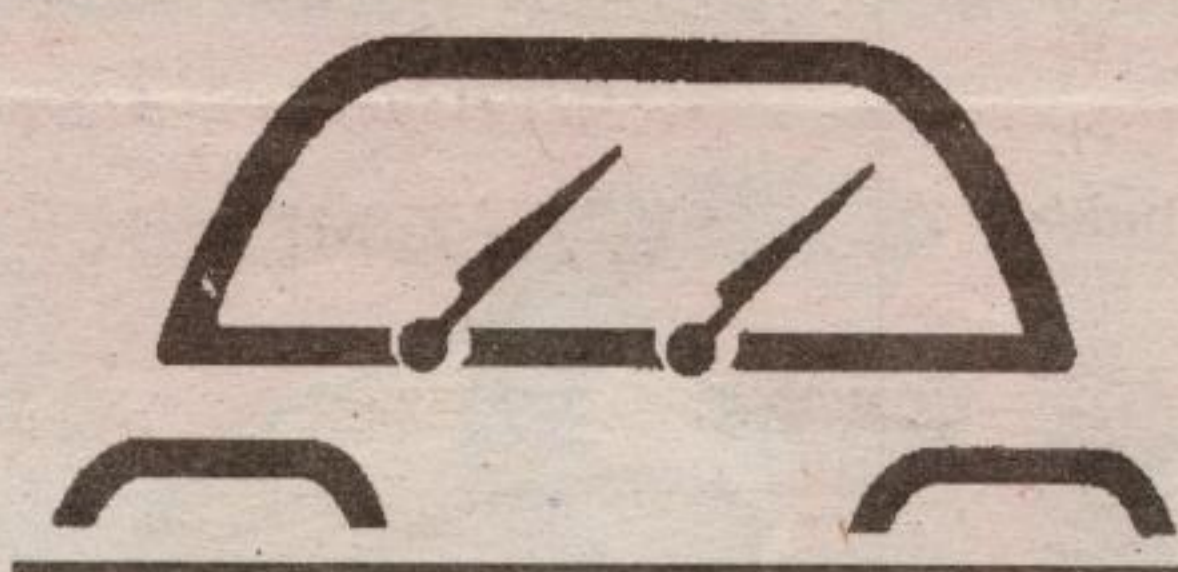
Halton Hills Library representative Margaret Felce accepted the donation as well as a matching donation presented by past president of Branch 120, Paul Yates.
