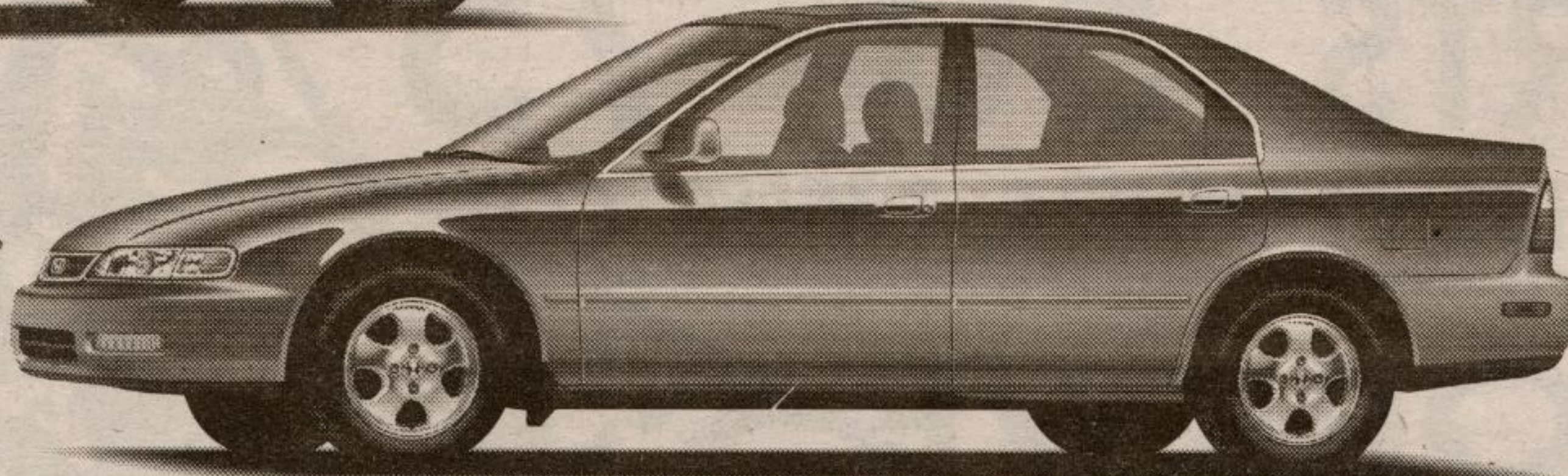

## Break-in thwarted

Halton police were called to break and enter in progress at a grocery store on Guelph St. Monday at 2:52 a.m.

When the police officer arrived two men were spotted behind the store. One scaled a fence and ran off while the other was caught by the officer. The culprits weren't successful in getting into the store. Police say the man who ran off wasn't caught despite a thorough search of the area and police are still trying to determine who he is.

Charged in connection with the attempted break-in is a 31-year-old Hamilton man. He is charged with attempt break and enter and possession of burglary tools, and was held for a bail hearing Monday morning.

## Police charge three

Halton police have charged three Guelph men in connection with an incident that occurred on Guelph St. last Monday night in which a Georgetown man was struck on the head and robbed.

Police say the victim was walking along the street when he was approached by several people, struck on the head with a metal instrument and had his money stolen. The victim suffered head injuries and was treated and released from Georgetown Hospital.

The three accused men, aged 19, 20, and 21, are to appear in Milton court on May 12.

**Q.** Last year I paid \$2,000 in tuition fees for my daughter, who is unmarried. Can I claim these on my tax return?

**A.** Probably. If your daughter does not need the full amount to reduce her tax payable to zero, she may transfer the unused portion to a parent or grandparent. However, if anyone claimed a personal amount for her (e.g. equivalent-to-spouse amount), she can only transfer it to the person who claimed this amount. Otherwise she can transfer the unused portion to the parent or grandparent of her choice.
