Signs urge Halton residents to stop park vandalism

Crime Stoppers of Halton Inc. has purchased signs for the municipal parks across Halton. The volunteer-managed group has started to deliver signs intended to drive home the message that parks are to enjoy, not destroy.

The blue and white signs will be posted by the municipalities and

encourage people to help stop park vandalism (and other community crimes) by calling Crime Stoppers.

John Griffiths, board chair for the program said, "The signs are being supplied in the hope that people responsible for damaging our community facilities will be identified.

It is our goal to reduce the incidence of vandalism to our parks and make them a more pleasant and safer place to visit."

Each sign will display the logo for the municipality involved and Crime Stoppers. The police co-ordinator for Crime Stoppers, Sgt. Rod Cliffe,

explained that all Crime Stoppers programs are based on a partnership between police, the media and the community.

"It was important to the board of directors to include the logo of the municipality in addition to our own to reflect the partnership Crime Stoppers feels it has with the communities in the fight against vandalism."

The signs are being delivered this month to Halton Hills.

TAX TALK

A PUBLIC SERVICE OF H&R BLOCK

Q. My income is so low that I have not filed a tax return for several years. Some of my friends tell me they have been receiving cheques for the GST credit. How do I apply for it?

A. To apply for the goods and services tax credit, you or your spouse must file a tax return (even if there is no income to report) and complete the GST application section. The credit you apply for on your 1996 return will be paid in instalments in 1997 and 1998. It is not too late to file returns for 1990 through 1995 to obtain the goods and services tax credits for those years. If eligible, you may also file to claim the federal sales tax credits for 1986 through 1990.
