Town's oldest resident dies at age 105

Halton Hills lost its oldest living resident as Gilbert English died Tuesday afternoon at the age of 105.

A resident of Esquesing Township, (now the Town of Halton Hills) since 1921, English served overseas during the First World War, serving with the 75th Battalion of the Canadian Expeditionary Force (C.E.F.) and was Royal Canadian Legion Branch 120's last surviving First World War

veteran. English was also an Honorary Member of the Toronto Scottish Regimental Association.

Always a regular at the annual Remembrance Day services at Georgetown Cenotaph, English was honored in November 1994, when he was asked to represent Branch 120 by laying a wreath at the National War Memorial in Ottawa on Remembrance Day.



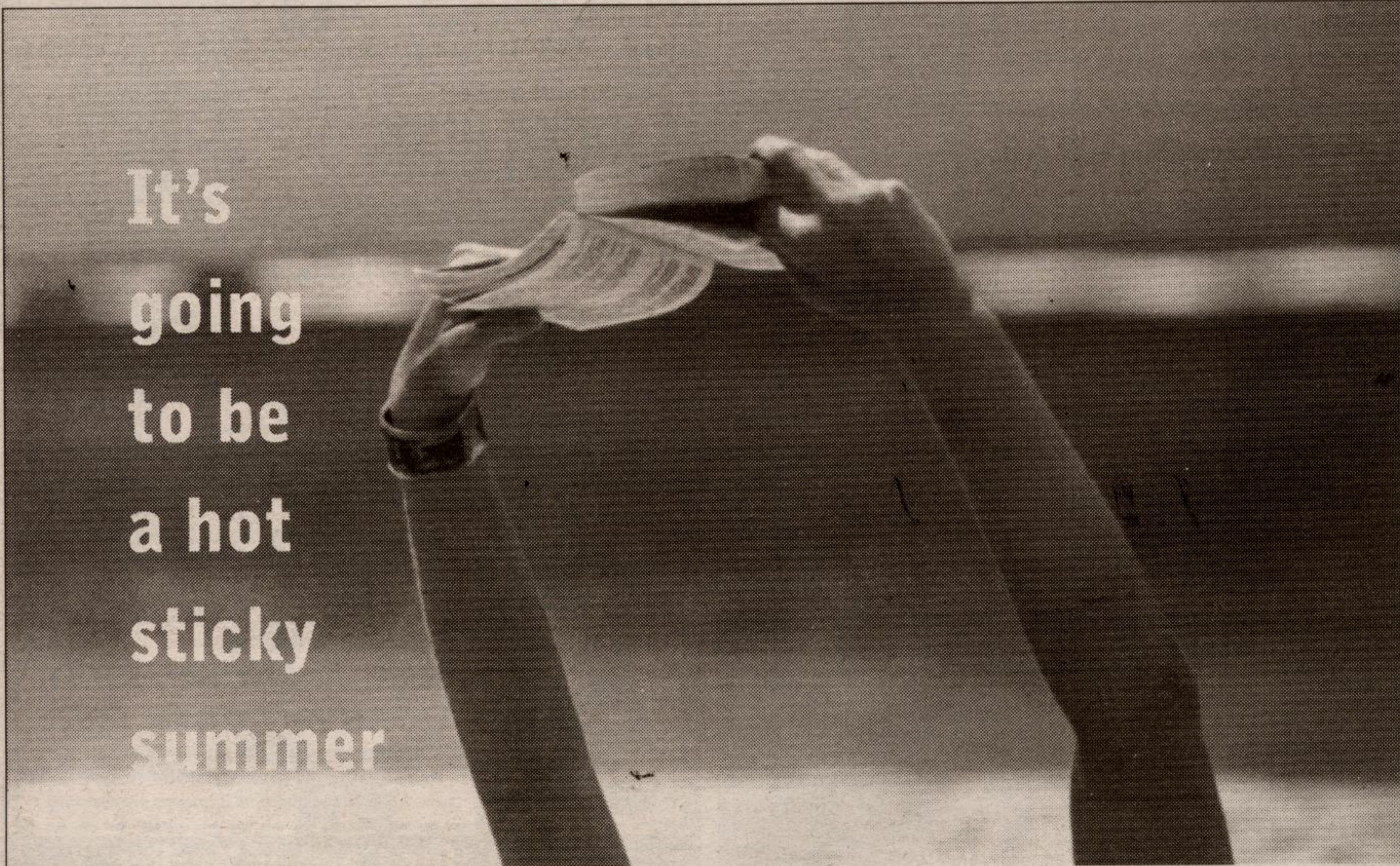

English resided on the family farm on the Fourth Line, and later lived with his son, George, on 15 Sideroad.

In addition to his activities with the Legion, English was also a dedicated member of St. John's Anglican Church in Stewarttown since 1921, serving in various capacities within the church, as well as a longtime member of the choir.

Gilbert was predeceased by wife Flora Anna Murray, and daughter Mary Wilson, and leaves behind sons George and Seymour and their families, including seven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Friends were received at J. S. Jones and Son Funeral Home, Thursday, and Branch 120 held a service in his honor Thursday evening. Funeral services were held Friday at 11 a.m. at the funeral home chapel.
