
The next branch executive meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. Thursday (tomorrow). The next general meeting is scheduled for 8 p.m. May 8.

The branch membership committee reminds those members who have changed residences in the past two years or so, to please contact the branch with the new address and telephone number.




