Branch 120 mourns the deaths this past week of two of its most respected and beloved members. Mr. Charles Gilbert English died at age 105 and Mr. Herb Brown died at age 73.

Mr. English was a WWI veteran, wounded in France, who was both Branch 120's oldest

member and the town's oldest resident. He served with the 75th Battalion of the Canadian Expeditionary Force and was also an honorary member of the Toronto Scottish Regimental Association.

He represented Branch 120 in ceremonies at the National Cenotaph in Ottawa in 1994.

Mr. Brown was a 50-year member of Branch 120 and served in Europe in WWII with the 3rd Brigade, 1st Division

Canadian Infantry.

Branch 120 extends sincere sympathy to the families of these two gentlemen. They will be missed and their memories revered.

Bond, Bill Barr, Flo Carswell and Colin Gibson.

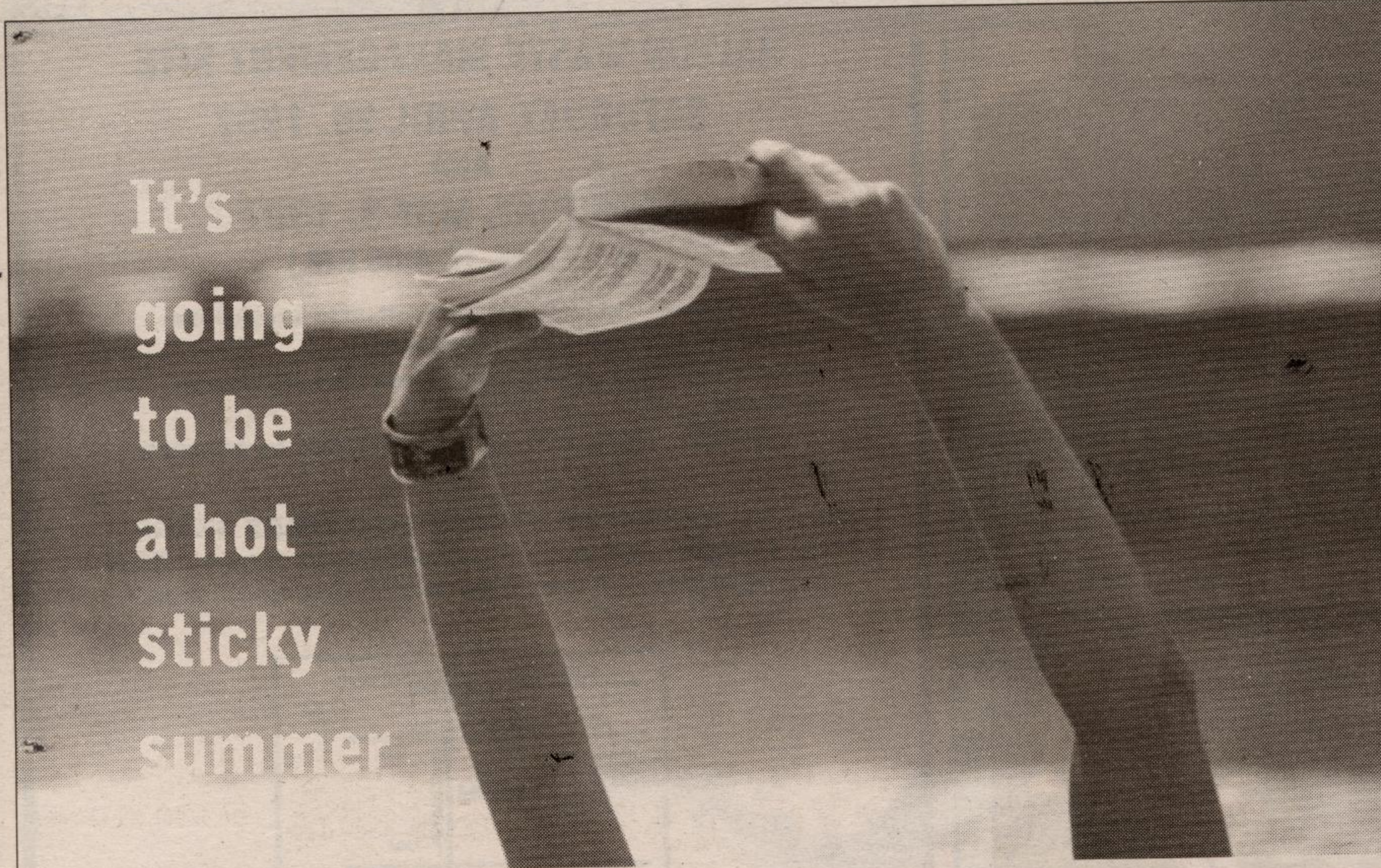
The next branch executive meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. Thursday (tomorrow). The next general meeting is scheduled for 8 p.m. May 8.
