Traditional and Gourmet Mega Pizza will offer more than your standard pizza when it opens in two weeks. Trudy Van Grootel, owner of the franchise in Acton, said Mega Pizza will offer pizzas from around the world.

Van Grootel said Mega Pizza's chef has recently perfected a Thai pizza, or a Thai pie, which includes blackened chicken and Cajun spice among its ingredients. A Mexican pizza using chili for sauce is currently in the works.

"We hope to introduce a new pizza every month," she said.

Mega Pizza will also give pizza lovers the opportunity to create their own pizza, although the choices may be somewhat more difficult. In addition to the traditional toppings, Mega Pizza will offer 30 gourmet toppings, including sun-dried tomatoes, marinated mushrooms and asparagus.

"It caters to the vegetarian market," Van Grootel said.

Van Grootel said the process in which makes the crust will also add the taste of the pizza. The dough will be made on site and the pizza will be baked on screens to keep the crust crisp.

Having managed a pizzeria before, Van Grootel said she knows

the customers' likes and dislikes. She said Mega Pizza's commitment was what interested her the most about becoming involved with the company.

"It's a franchise that really cares about the pizza or they wouldn't hire a chef," Van Grootel said.

In addition to pizza, Mega Pizza will offer fresh Greek and Caesar

salads, nachos, gyros, wings, pesto bread and bruschetta.

Mega Pizza is a Canadian-owned chain with 15 other locations. The Acton outlet will be the first to feature Mega Pizza's new look.

Mega Pizza offers take-out and free delivery. It is located at 115 Mill St. East in Acton and can be reached when it opens at 853-3030.

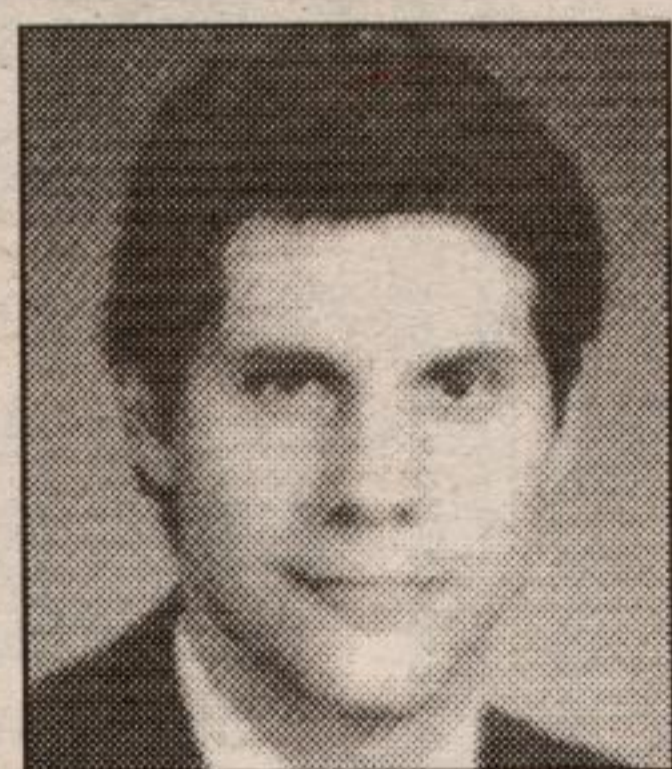
