Christopher Kargel kicked off the outdoor season with four top-three finishes at the fifth annual Al Nichols Track and Field Meet in Oakville.

Kargel competed in the elementary open division against competitors one or two years older than him. Kargel won the long jump with a personal best of 4.41m. He was second in the high jump topping the 1.60m mark but couldn't clear the winning mark of 1.63m.

Using the 4kg shot for the first time, Kargel's throw of 8.53m was good for second place.

In his final event, Kargel established another personal best with a time of 13.32 seconds in the 100m for third place.
