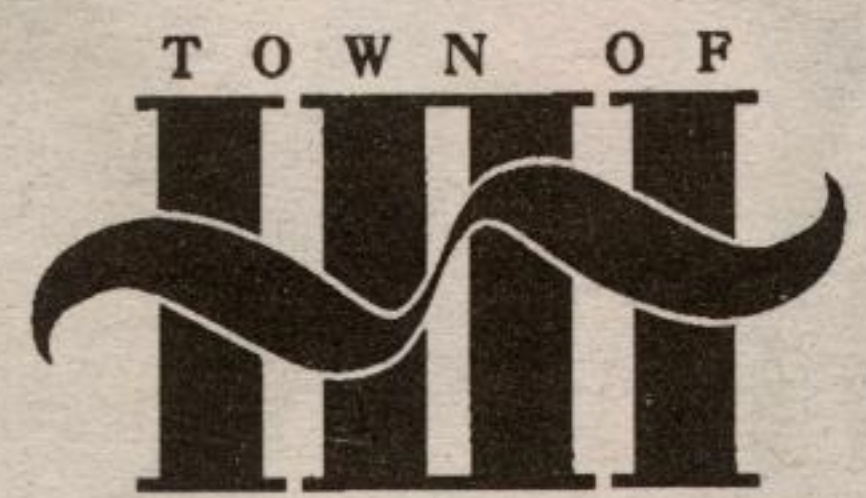


Top citizen Hoare to be honored at Legion May 23

It's all in a day's work for Georgetown's Hazel Gorin

Donning leather to battle dust is 'fun'

From having orange peels stuffed up her nostrils to beating the dust out of a couch with a bullwhip while dressed in studded black leather— Hazel Gorin's commercial career could never be described as boring.

Last August Georgetown resident Gorin was featured in a Wampole print advertisement that ran in Reader's Digest and she can currently be seen across the country as a tough-looking maid sporting black leather in a Reactine television commercial. Gorin, who has been involved in amateur theatre for about 20 years and calls herself strictly an amateur actor, is having great fun.

"Even if you don't get it, (the job she's up for) it's fun," said Gorin. "You meet a lot of interesting people. It's an odd business."

When Gorin auditioned for the Reactine spot she had no idea what the commercial was about.

She said at the casting call she was told to mess up her hair, smile, flare her nostrils and look aggressive in front of the camera. She was called back a couple of more times and asked how she felt about wearing leather, to which she responded "No problem."

She said she was dumbfounded when she learned she got the job and when

she tried on the leather get-up she "just howled."

Before shooting the commercial in

February Gorin practised whipping the couch in her basement with a bullwhip the advertiser provided her with. The commercial, produced by Taxi Production Co., was shot over two 14-hour days in a studio in Toronto.

"The hardest part was standing there under the hot lights in the leather and keeping a deadpan look," said Gorin. She added the whipping caused her arm to ache for three days.

Gorin said she was very lucky to get the national commercial. She was paid for the shooting and is also paid for the number of airings. The commercial will also be aired in Britain in a show called Commercial Breakdown that features the best of the world's funniest commercials.

"Commercials don't come fast and furious," said Gorin. "I might never get another one like it."

Gorin also has a small part in an independent film that recently shot in Toronto, and is waiting to hear whether or not she will appear in a German cigarette commercial. She was also seen in Globe's The Secret Garden and had a chance to wear the black leather outfit from the commercial, which she kept as a souvenir, during an appearance in Sweet Charity at Meadowvale Theatre.

Her retired husband Ken has also recently got himself an agent and has already done a voice over for a brewing company.

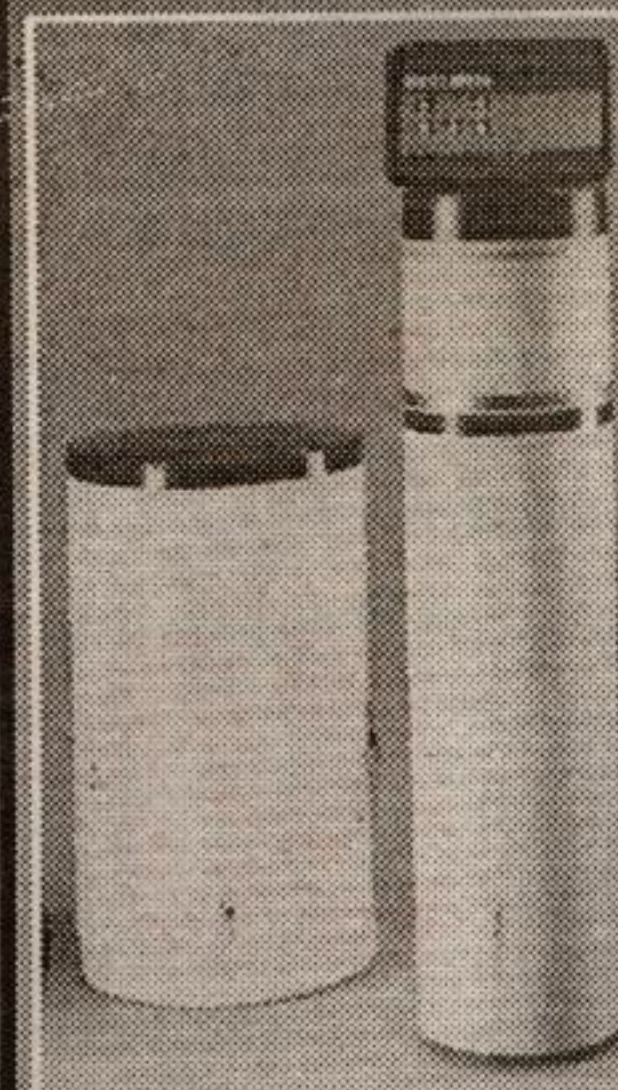
Georgetown woman faces intoxication, drug charges
