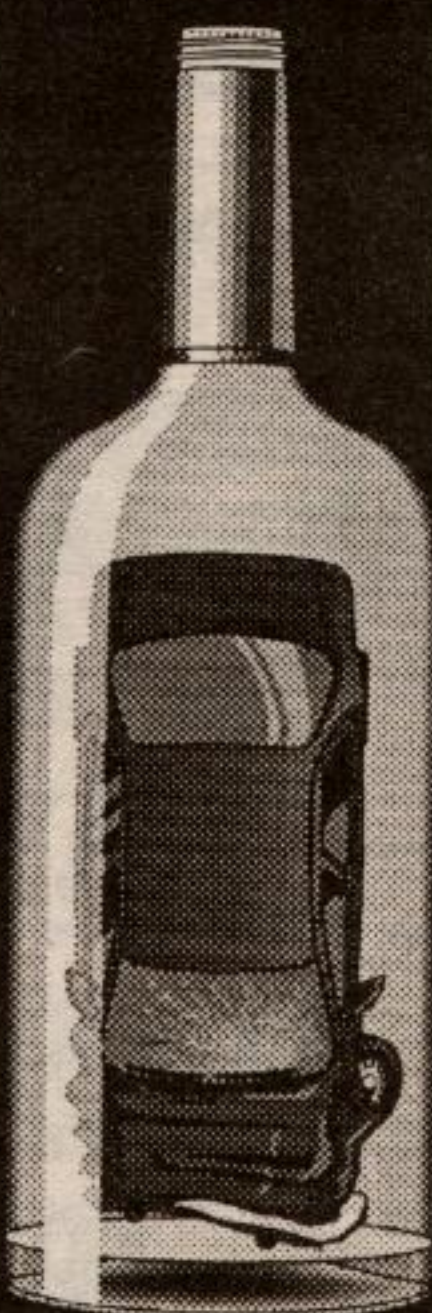
### Manitoba flood relief
