Next Tuesday's encore performance of Kids on Broadway to aid flood relief effort

Georgetown Children's Chorus will be holding a benefit concert for Winnipeg flood relief on May 20 at 7:30 p.m. at the John Elliott Theatre.
 In April, the choir presented

Kids on Broadway, a concert of 30 Broadway favorites sung by 160 children, aged four to 18. The show will be repeated in its entirety. Over 900 people attended the concerts but the choir is hoping to attract those who missed it the first time.

"The flood victims have enough food and clothing now. What they need now is money to rebuild," said organizer Lois Fraser. "Our kids are also going to make a giant card to go along with our donations."

At a recent choir practice, the teens decided that they would like to raise funds for Winnipeg. They had seen the devastation on TV and were shocked by the photos.

Community support for the relief effort has been tremendous. When the announcement of the choir benefit was made at the Kiwanis Lobsterfest on Friday night, Fraser said, local business people responded with on the spot donations totalling \$3,500.

"When the subject of a benefit concert was raised, the kids were unanimous," said Dale Wood, music director. "Even though it means extra rehearsals for them, they want to show in a concrete way that we care about what is happening in Manitoba."

Tickets for Kids on Broadway are \$10 each and are on sale now at the theatre box office, 877-3700. The choir hopes to raise a further \$2,500 that will go to the flood relief efforts.

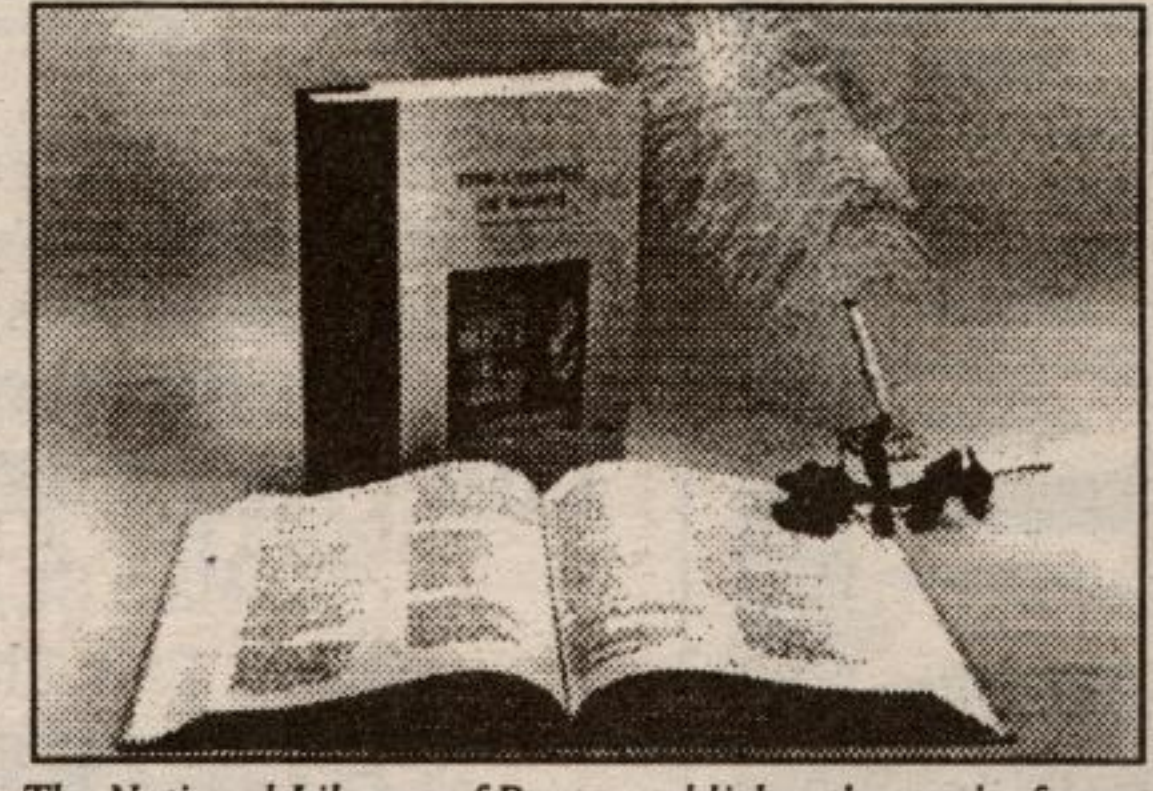

New Poetry Contest \$48,000.00 in Prizes

The National Library of Poetry to award 250 total prizes to amateur poets in coming months



Owings Mills, Maryland - The National Library of Poetry has just announced that \$48,000.00 in prizes will be awarded over the next 12 months in the brand new North American Open Amateur Poetry Contest. The deadline for entry into the contest is June 15, 1997. Another contest begins June 16, 1997. The contest is open to everyone and entry is free.

The National Library of Poetry publishes the work of amateur poets in colorful hardbound anthologies like *The Coming of Dawn*, pictured above. Each volume features poetry by a diverse mix of poets from all over the world.

"We're especially looking for poems from new or unpublished poets," indicated Howard Ely, spokesperson for The National Library of Poetry. "We have a ten year history of awarding large prizes to talented poets who have never before won any type of writing competition."

The poem should be no more than 20 lines, and the poet's name and address must appear on the top of the page. Entries must be postmarked by June 15, 1997. "All poets who enter will receive a response concerning their artistry," indicated Mr. Ely.
