The only drawback since opening her consignment clothing store, Clothes to the Edge, is that it has cut into her own shopping.

"I frequented them all the time. I do most of my shopping in second hand stores," Rooke said. "I haven't been to a consignment store in a couple of months. I don't have time anymore."

Rooke said the strength of her store is the variety it offers. Clothes to the Edge has sections for working women, men, children and teenagers. That has been reflected in the store's clientele.

"Because of what we're carrying I figured we would have a real cross section," Rooke said.

And with two teenagers of her own, son James and daughter Rachel, Rooke also has a couple of scouts to keep her on top of trends.

"They look at something and say, 'That will sell,' and I look at it and I'm thinking, 'That's kind of rough.' But they're right. Their judgment is usually pretty good."

Clothes to the Edge also has some locally-made new clothing.

"There's a young girl in Acton making dresses and tie-up pants," Rooke said. "They're very popular with the teenagers."

Clothes to the Edge also carries an assortment of silver and stained glass jewelry, jewelry boxes and incense.

Once Rooke made the decision to go into business, she wasted little time. Three weeks after first seeing the store for rent, Rooke was open for business. Since opening, Rooke said the response has been terrific.

"Most people have said this is something the town has needed," she said.

The store, which opened in the first week of April, will be holding a sale to mark its arrival in Acton the week of May 20-24. There will be door prizes and special prices.

It will kick off with a body piercer visiting the store on May 18. Piercings will be done by appointment only.

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
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
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
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
