During the evening, health department staff will be on hand in the library providing information and short presentation on drug awareness.

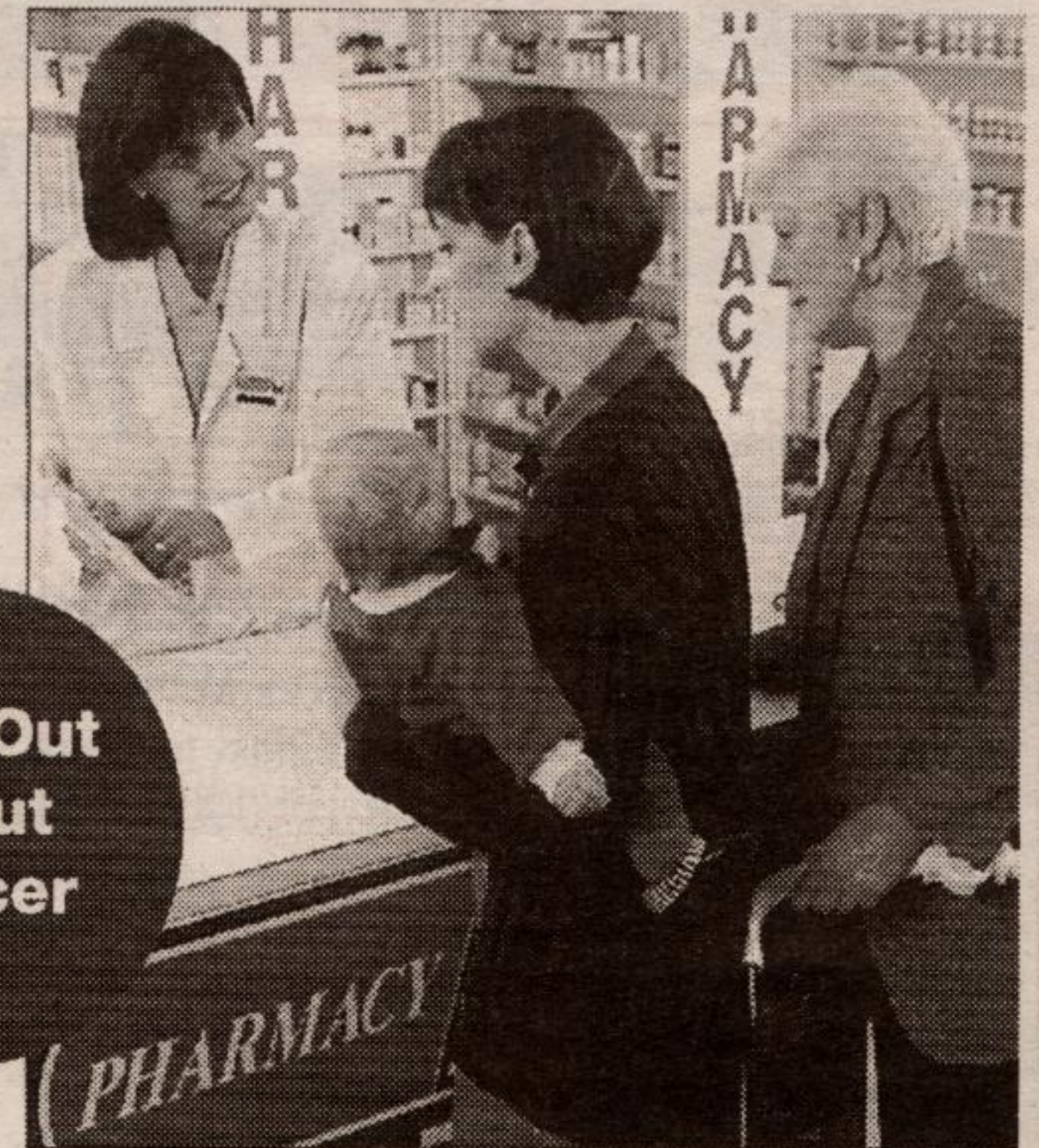
