Selects claim bronze medal by topping Waterdown

The Peel Selects defeated the Waterdown Raiders to win the bronze medal at the Ontario Volleyball Association Junior Women's Championships.

The Selects had split their previous four meetings with Waterdown but prevailed in the bronze medal game 15-9, 15-9. The victory qualifies the Selects for the national championships May 1-3 in Kingston.

The Selects' roster includes Missy

Archdekin of Georgetown and the team is coached by Christine Craig of Acton.

The Selects were ranked fifth heading into the tournament after an injuryplagued season. The Selects went 2-1 in pool play, defeating the Quinte Cougars 15-7, 15-2 and the Scarborough Eclipse 15-2, 15-7. The Selects then met the secondseeded team, London's Forest City. Peel jumped out to a 14-9 lead in the opening game but Forest City roared back to win 16-14 and then took game two 15-10.

The Selects came through with an outstanding effort against the Hamilton Seekers in the quarterfinals. After taking the opening game 15-8 they lost a close 15-13 decision. However, the Selects rolled through the final game, winning 15-3.

The semifinals were a huge test for the Selects as they faced the defending national champions and number one seeded team, the Scarborough Nova. Scarborough proved to be too tough, winning 15-7, 15-4.

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
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
