Ichael Halashyn of Georgetown was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis (MS) three years ago and this year he and his family will be walking in the first-ever Super Cities Walk for MS, to be held in north Halton on April

"It's ironic that I waited until walking was difficult before getting involved in a walk," said Halashyn. "Please support our walk and help us all beat this thing."

Beginning from E.C. Drury School for the Deaf, in Milton, on Sunday, April 19, 9:30 a.m., Milton and Halton Hills residents will be among the more than 26,000 walkers in 39 communities across Ontario to raise funds for MS programs and services. The local walk is organized by the Halton

chapter of the MS Society.

Halton chapter organizers are expecting 250 north Halton walkers will raise \$25,000 in the first local walk. Proceeds will provide services for local residents.

Multiple sclerosis attacks the central nervous system of people in the prime of their life causing varied symptoms including numbness, loss of balance, extreme fatigue and possible paralysis. Its cause is unknown, its cure undiscovered and its effect on each victim unpredictable.


Tens of thousands of Canadians have the disease— one of the highest rates in the world.
