Residents need permit for open air burning

In light of the recent grass fires that may have been started from open air burning, Halton Hills Fire Department wants area residents to be aware of several factors if they are considering doing any burning.

Anyone in the town of Halton Hills who wants to do any open air burning needs a burn permit.

Open air burning isn't permitted unless it is approved, or if it is a small confined fire, supervised at all times, and used to cook food on a grill or barbecue.

If a burn permit is requested, arrangements must be made with a fire inspector to inspect the site and 48 hours notice is required.

Anyone who violates the conditions of the burn permit could result in the fire department extinguishing the fire, the revoking or refusal of future open air burning permits, and charges being laid under the authority of the Fire Marshals Act.

If a person is burning without a permit, or is violating the conditions of the permit, the full costs of putting out the fire, including labor and equipment costs as determined by the fire department, could be charged to the property owner or permit holder.

The fire department says people should not burn on windy days, and trash, plastics and rubbers, etc., should-

n't be burned.

If in doubt residents should call the fire department at 877-1133 for direction and approval.
