

Helpful auto cleaning tips to restore your car's 'spring'

Inally spring, and along with it, spring cleaning! What better way to eliminate all signs of winter and welcome the new season? Yes, we know there must be better ways, but sometimes work comes before pleasure. As you get set to dust off the cob webs of winter, don't forget that your vehicle may have "lost its spring" over the past few months and will need some attention too.

• Air out the interior, vacuum thoroughly, clean all plastic and vinyl surfaces and clean the inside of your windshield and windows.

• Wash the outside of your vehicle taking care to spray salt and dirt out from under the wheel wells and rocker panels.

• Replace any burned out light bulbs and worn wiper blades.

 Touch up any paint chips to help prevent rust formation.

• Check all fluid levels. Consult your vehicle owner's manual for important recommendations regarding intervals for oil, filter and antifreeze changes. Remember that anti-freeze isn't just for winter. It also will help to prevent your vehicle from overheating in the hot days ahead.

 Check all belts for signs of wear such as cracking or frayed edges. Belts should be tight and should not give more than three quarters of an inch. • The radiator and heater hoses also should be checked for leaks. Hoses should feel firm but not overly hard. If they are spongy, cracked, overly hard or have any bulges, they should be replaced.

 Remove accumulated corrosion from battery terminals. Cable ends can be cleaned with a wire brush and a water and baking soda solution. Wipe off the top of the battery with a dry cloth.


Check your tires. Look for

your tires is the same as that recommended by the vehicle manufacturer. Under inflation creates excessive heat which reduces tire life, can cause tire failure and will reduce fuel efficiency.

• Give your vehicle a tune up. The engine oil should be of the summer grade recommended by the vehicle manufacturer. Suspension and steering linkages should be checked, brake linings inspected for wear, and the battery tested for proper levels and charge.

By investing a little time, "elbow grease" and money in your vehicle, you can avoid problems that can be expensive to fix if neglected. So go ahead, pamper your vehicle...then go out and enjoy the sights and sounds of spring.
