

Town hikes film production rate

The Town of Halton Hills has hiked the cost of filming film, television and commercial productions here.

Council approved a new film production guideline policy Sept. 14 which will charge production companies \$500 a day to work here. Most neighboring municipalities charge nothing or about \$100 a day.

Acton Councillor Norm Elliott wondered whether the town could be discouraging a potential revenue generator as well as resulting tourism spinoffs after the town is listed in the movie credits.

Town administrator Steve Andrews said that production companies' budgets are usually so high that the \$500 fee would not impose a hardship.

As well, the production companies will be

required to pay a damage deposit, pay rental fees for any town properties or equipment; pay for advertising costs to notify residents of the film company; pay for any building permit (i.e. for the erection of stages or tents) and payment for any services such as pay-duty officers or installation of signs. Staff will also negotiate with the company for a donation towards town improvement— for example leaving the site in better condition than it was originally.

The new policy had been prompted by numerous requests to shoot within Halton Hills for various productions and the resulting additional workload placed on town staff. Halton Hills' proximity to Toronto and its picturesque settings are key reasons for filming here.


Halton Police want auxiliary officers

You're wanted by the police!


