Dear editor,

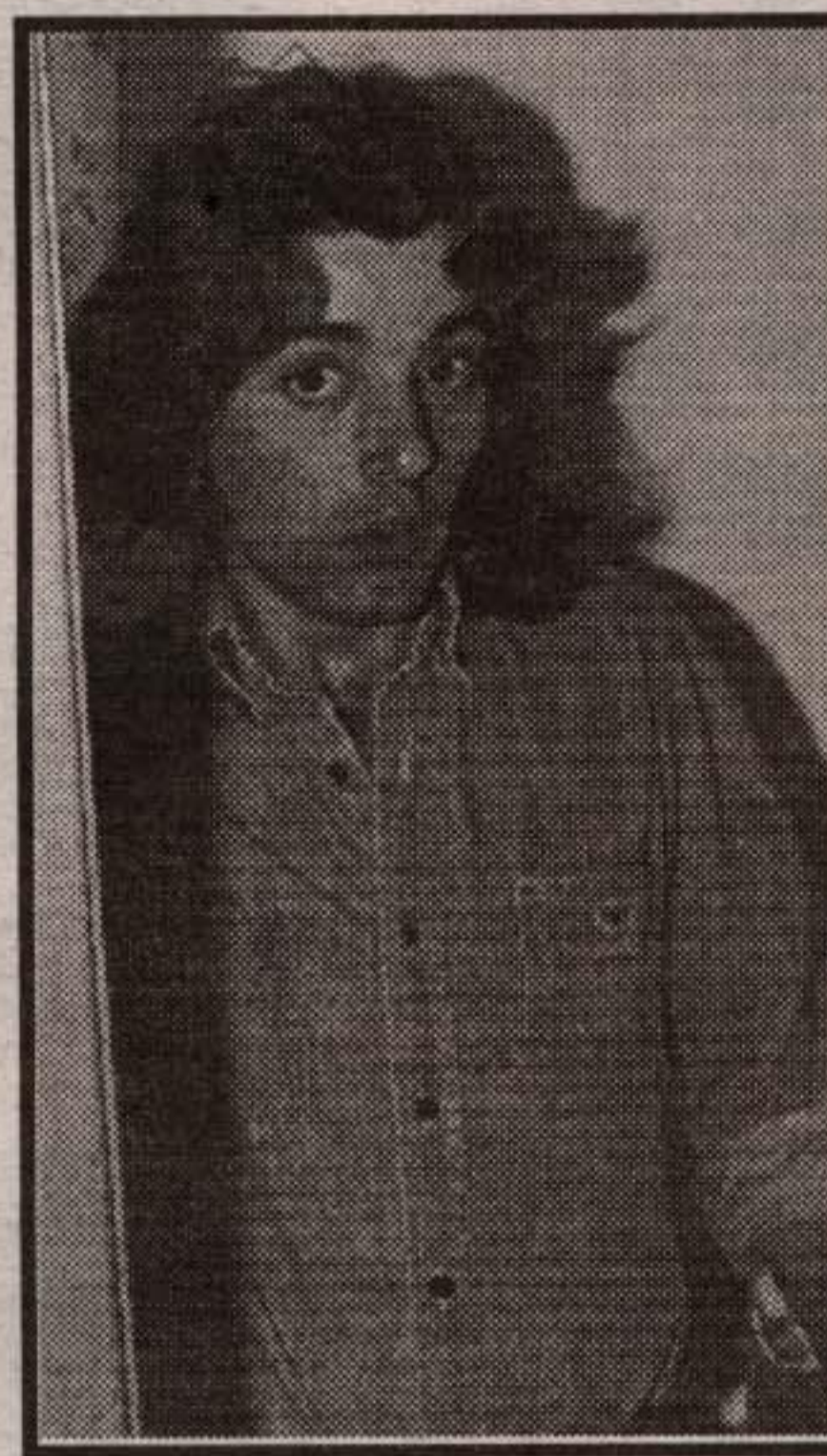
