Capture the Hills this weekend

Once again, local shutterbugs will be able to get out and enjoy capturing the beauty of Halton Hills on film during Halton Hills Camera Club's annual Capture the Hills '98, September 26 and 27.

The two-day shoot will run, rain or shine, from 7 a.m. Saturday until 10 p.m. Sunday, and all photos must be taken within the boundaries of Halton Hills.

Cost of the competition is \$25 and includes one 24-exposure roll of film, complete with processing.

The film is returned to Halton Camera Exchange and competitors can pick them up October 2 or 3 to select their entries for the

competition. Competitors can enter up to six photos in total, but no more than two per category. There are three categories; People, Creatures and Critters; Scenery, Foliage and Flowers; and Halton Hills Heritage.

Open to all non-professional photographers, registration is limited to 100 entrants. Deadline for registration is noon Sept. 26 at the Halton Camera Exchange.

All entries and the winning photos will be on display at an awards ceremony October 22 at Halton Hills Civic Centre.

New exhibit opens at Williams Mill on Saturday

A new exhibit, Scorched Earth, officially opens at The Williams Mill Creative Arts Studios and Gallery this Saturday, Sept. 26, 2-5 p.m. The exhibit continues until Oct. 18.

Artists, Wendy Cooper Melbye and Fraser Forsythe, have collaborated on a collection of works in copper and clay, celebrating the dynamics of fire. They will attend the opening.

Cooper Melbye is a painter and printmaker whose work in oil and encaustic is well known.

She has become intrigued with the possibilities of enamel and copper and the variety of firing techniques that can produce different effects.

Forsythe has been experimenting with raku and pit firing and this show will demonstrate his expertise in these techniques.

Williams Mill houses the working studios of 30 artists and craftspeople. Many studios are open to the public. A gallery is open Wednesdays to Sundays, noon to 5 p.m. Studio hours vary.
