

Chalmers recommends a tune-up for your furnace

The winter just around the corner now is the time for area residents to ensure their furnaces are in good working order.

For more than 36 years Chalmers Fuels has been meeting the heating and cooling comfort needs of their customers in Halton, Peel and Wellington County.
