Cable company to add new sports channel

Western Co-Axial Limited will add CTV Sports Net to its lineup on October 9, the day the new regional sports channel takes to the air. Billed as "the dawn of a new era in Canadian sports broadcasting," CTV will launch Canada's first regional sports service with the mandate to forge the strongest possible relationship with sports fans across the country.

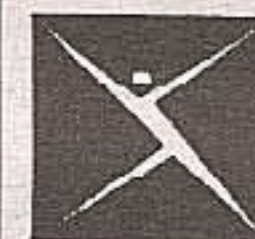
"We've had a flood of requests from our customers since the channel's licensing was announced by the CRTC," said John Levy, the cable company's president. Sports Net can be previewed until December 31 at no charge on channel 54.

On January 1, Sports Net will migrate into one of our existing packages and therefore, be available to all of our customers.

"It is our philosophy to give our customers the ultimate choice and selection as part of our discretionary tiers," said Levy.

CTV Sports Net will offer programming in four regions: Central (Ontario); Pacific (B.C.); West (Prairie Provinces); and East (Quebec and the Maritimes plus the Ottawa Valley.) Starting this October, the network has the Canadian cable rights to NHL telecasts for the next four years, promising 44 games including playoffs.

Founded in 1959, Western Co-Axial is a Hamilton based, family-owned cable company providing entertainment, communications and information services to Hamilton, Grimsby, North Halton, Milton, Fergus, Elora and surrounding areas. The company also provides Internet services through its subsidiary, Weslink Datalink Corporation.
