Acton Sox sink Chiefs for A Division championship

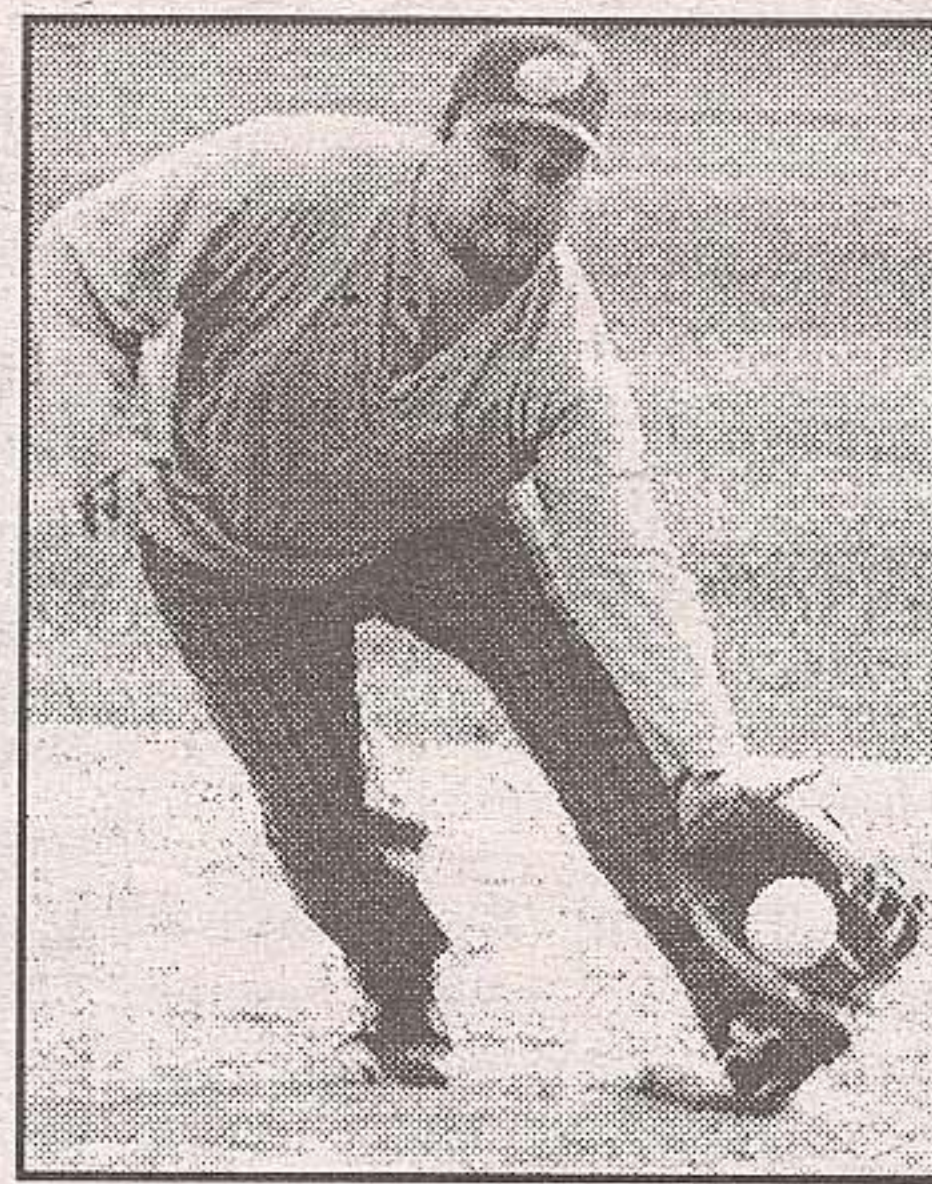

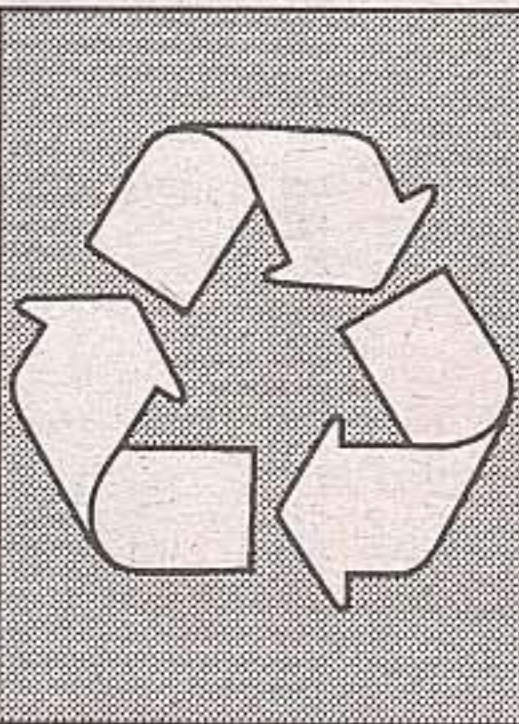
