Tips to close up the cottage

s fall sets in, another ritual begins in the "great outdoors" — closing up the cottage for winter.

It's not so much the chill that cottage owners worry about, but the damage that ice, show, animals and vandals can cause. Although every cottage is different and every cottage owner's closing check list is different, here are some basics to keep in mind.

 Remove any valuables that could attract vandals, such as televisions, stereo and other electronic equipment.

• Remove any food that might attract rats and other pests.

 Remove docks and boats from the water.

• Remove or hide any sharp or destructive tools such as knives, axes, saws, crowbars and hammers. Fire extinguishers can cause a mess, but could be useful in case of fire. Use your best judgement on whether to take these or leave them behind.

• Don't just close down your plumbing system— drain it. This will prevent pipes from cracking and breaking over the winter. To drain your system, empty and clean all the pipes, valves, tanks and pumps. But before you begin, be sure to turn off the water heater both at the tank and at the circuit breaker. Also, put some antifreeze in the toilet bowl in case all the water hasn't drained.

• Aim to keep out those critters that love to move in when you move out. Bats, mice and squirrels can wiggle in through the smallest of holes. Try to

block any entry areas during the summer when most of these animals are feeding outdoors.

• Do place a wooden cap on the chimney to discourage birds and small animals from entering, and to stop any rain or snow.

• Keeping out vandals is a different kind of challenge. If you leave the cottage secured like a vault (plywood over windows and doors), you are encouraging forced entry and more damage is likely than if you left the door unlocked.

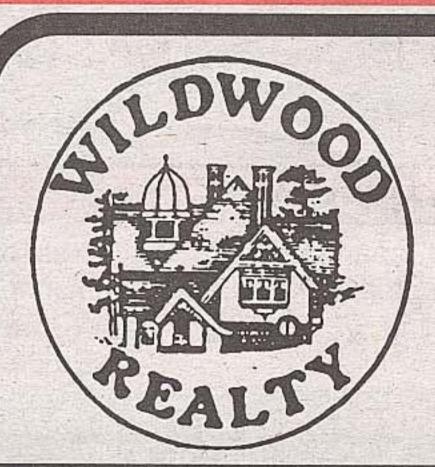
Regardless of your choice, always leave a note on the front door with a local number through which you may be reached. This way, if the roof collapses or the cottage is vandalized, a passerby can call you if they wish.

• To ensure the stove, fridge and other electrical equipment are not used in your absence, remove fuses and hide them in a safe place. This means cleaning up and emptying out the fridge first.

• If your cottage is in a heavy snow area, consider installing temporary supports to protect the roof from caving in. Another option is to hire a reliable local person to shovel the snow off the roof when necessary.

• Store boat motors, lawnmowers and other items with engines in a dry, weather-proof place. Cover anything that may rust over the winter with a coat of oil.

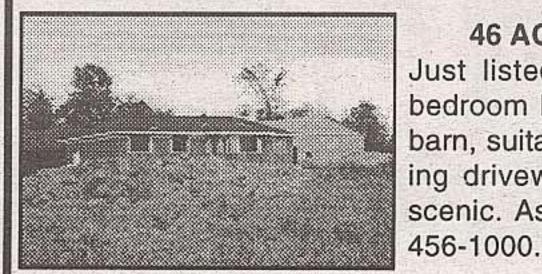
