


Learn to stamp

Guest speaker Kathy Miller from the Halton Regional Health Department will present a program called Mixing Colors. This program is designed to promote the safe use of medications.


If you take any prescription drugs, over-the-counter drugs or herbal remedies, then you might be interested in coming out to learn more about combining certain medications and how to use them safely.
