Gordie Tapp entertains here Friday

GORDIE TAPP

Torld famous "Cousin Clem" comes to George-town this Friday, Oct. 16

at the John Elliott Theatre. Comedian Gordie Tapp

will share the stage with the Westminster Chimes in the Fall Follies at the John Elliott Theatre. There will be two shows; a 2 p.m. matinee and an 8 p.m. evening performance.

Tapp is a Canadian comedy legend, who has been delighting radio and television audiences for over 50

years. Best known for the television variety show, Hee Haw, has been inducted into the Country Music Hall of Honor as well as the Country Music Hall of Fame. His most recent honor was his appointment as a Member of the Order of Canada.

Tapp, a Burlington resident, will close the first half of the show with a stand-up bit, which local performer Merv Kaye calls "pure comedy." In the second half he will have the audience rolling in the aisles with his very popular "Cousin Clem" bit.

The Westminster Chimes is a Greater Toronto Area group of veteran entertainers of singers, dancers, musicians and comedians performing in the British music hall tradition. Local members are Margaret Eggleton-Kaye and Merv Kaye. Eggleton-Kaye will include her North American-famous comedy bit: The Queen. Kaye, a veteran singer

with big bands, will show off his emceeing and singing skills.

Special guest will be local soprano Sandra Greig.

Tickets are \$10 for the matinee and \$12 for the evening performance. Tickets are available at the John Elliott Theatre Box Office, 877-3700.


Proceeds for the matinee will go to the Georgetown Seniors Centre. The


