Local schools removed from closure review list

He also explained the two school categories recommended for removal from the closure review. Recommendations were based on how projected year 2002 enrolments for areas compare with their pupil capacities.

"In the first category there will be more students than spaces in the review area," said Sadler. "In the second category, the excess capacity is less than any single school in the review area. You cannot close a school and resolve the situation."

Recommended for removal from the closure review process are the following Halton Hills schools:

First category:

Halton Hills- Georgetown District H.S., George Kennedy, Harrison, Centennial, Park, Glen Williams, Joseph Gibbons, Stewarttown.

Second category:

Halton Hills- Acton H.S., Limehouse, Pineview.

Debbie Oakville Trustee Marklew was another who warned these schools may not be safe from major changes.

"The facilities are not going to close, but what goes on inside could change," she noted. "Building reconfigurations could be just as emotional as school closings and consolidations."

She said reconfigurations (changing the makeup of a school) and boundary changes haven't received enough attention and could occur with little notice.


But superintendent Al Greyson said staff cannot go off making recommendations strictly on their own. "We're fully aware of the implications of the short time lines," he said. "But we need direction from the committee."
