Kim was in her fourth year of the business program at Wilfrid Laurier University, and was working at Microsoft Canada Co. in Mississauga for her co-op placement.

Sandy said her daughter was looking forward to going to France in January to study international business.

Kim attended Park and Stewarttown Public Schools

and Georgetown District High School.

Sandy said her daughter was very active in sports. She did gymnastics and played baseball, and in high school volleyball was her main activity. She was on the school's volleyball team and was also chosen to play on the allstar team.

Her mother said Kim was very focused on her university studies and friends and family were very important to her.

"She had such a good balance between her personal life and her goals," said Sandy. "She did so much living in her life."

"She lived life and she loved it," said her father. "There was no moss under her feet."

Kim was fondly remembered by her friends.

"She was the most dedicated person in whatever she did—her friendships, school or athletics," said long-time pal Andrea Herner.

"Whether you knew her for five minutes or five years to know her was to love her," said another friend Kelly Ballinger.

"She touched all of us (her friends) in a unique and loving way," said Kelly Gidden, another long-time friend.

To honor Kim's memory Herner, Ballinger, Gidden and some other friends have established an annual scholarship at Georgetown District High School in Kim's name. Each year a graduating student who exemplifies Kim's qualities will be awarded the scholarship.
