

# Celebration of Peace culminates Remembrance ceremonies Sunday

Every year at Remembrance time, we take time to remember the sacrifices made by those who went to war and those who never returned. We also celebrate the peace we have enjoyed, the peace many of us take for granted because we have never known anything else.

For the past five years, the Georgetown Choral Society and the Georgetown Children's Chorus have held an annual concert to praise, in song, those who have made lasting peace possible. This year, A Celebration of Peace, will take place this Sunday, Nov. 8, 7:30 p.m. at Holy Cross Church in Georgetown. Both choirs are directed by A. Dale Wood. Last year more than 600 citizens and veterans attended the concert. Admission is free and all are welcome. Coffee and cookies will be served afterwards.

The evening has been arranged by Tom Schenk and the Dutch Canadian Remembrance Committee and by Rev. Peter Barrow and Rev. John Giurin and the Georgetown District Ministerial Association.

"The initial thrust is, of course, towards the veterans," said Rev. Barrow, "but unfortunately as the years slide by they are getting fewer and fewer, so we have to bolster the group with those of us who do remember and those of us, who though we have nothing to remember, yet would not forget that our peace was only earned by much sacrifice."

Besides many beautiful songs of peace and unity, there will be poems read and some thoughtful words from the children who went to Holland and France last year on their Ambassadors of Peace tour. The Canadian Legion will also participate.

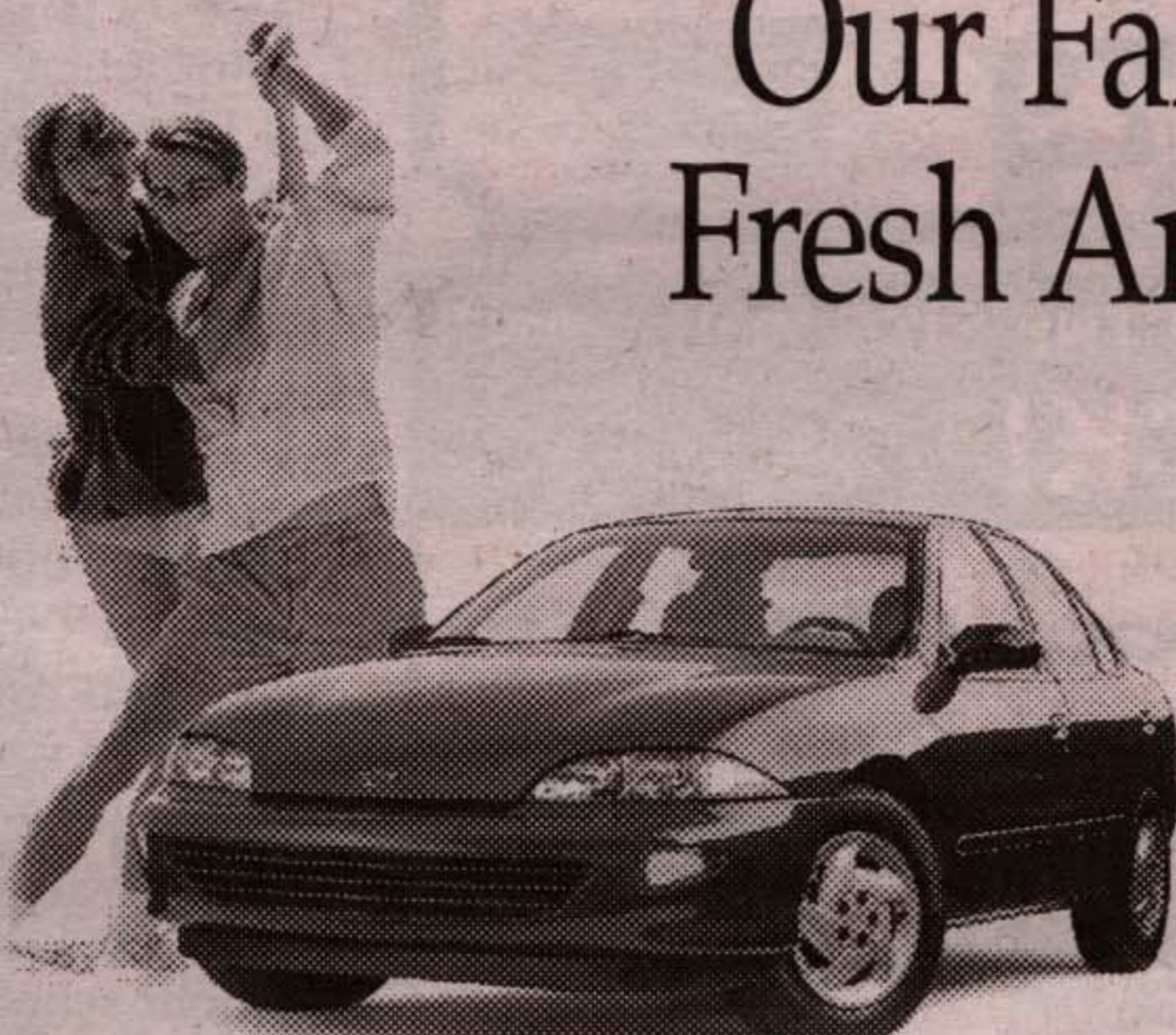
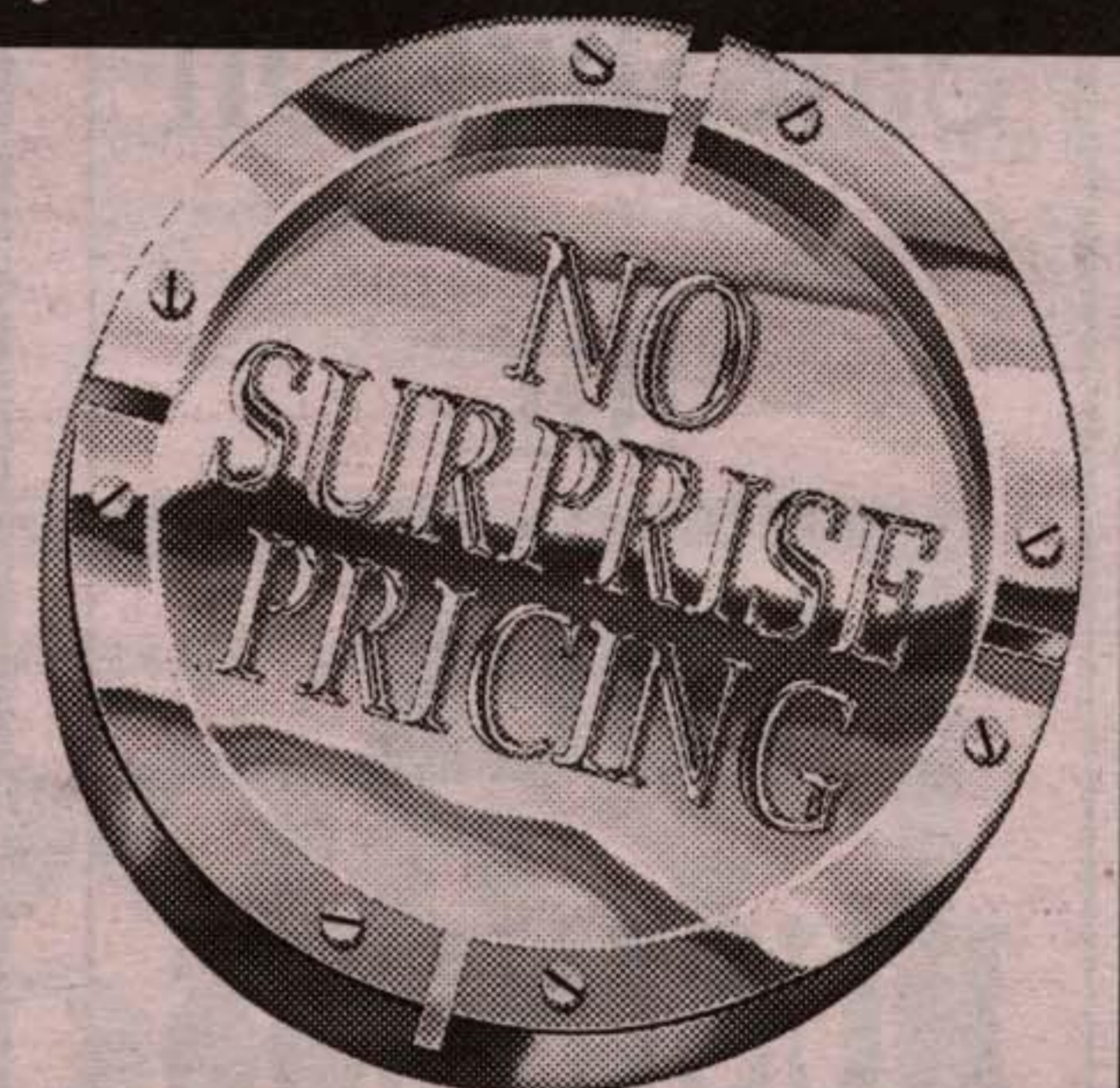
The public is invited for an inspiring evening of song in celebration of the peace.

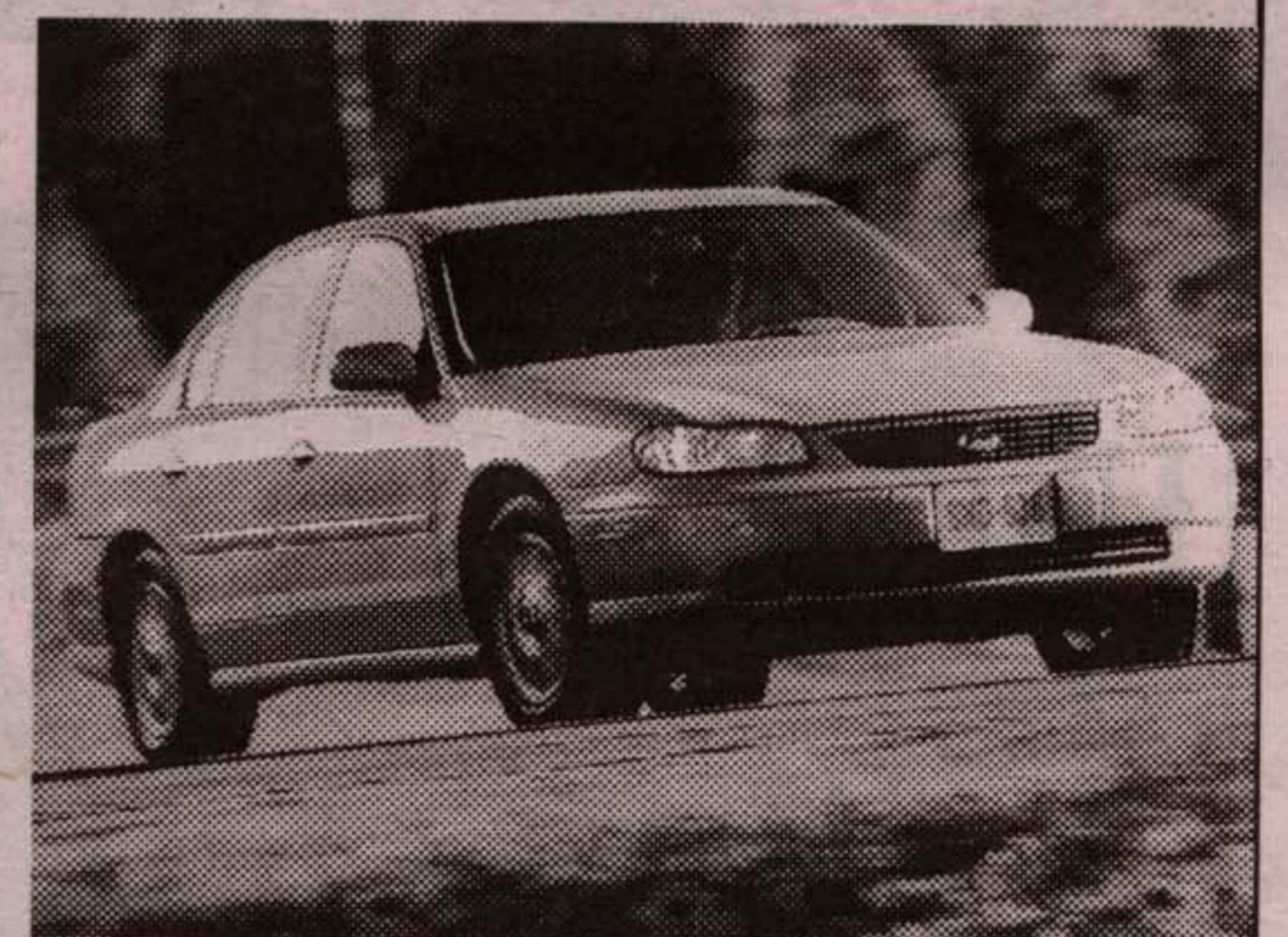

**Tooth Chatter**

**CHEWING FUNCTION**  
Learning to eat normally will require some effort on your part. For the first few days, eat soft foods. As you become accustomed to your dentures you may progress to solid food. Cut your food into small pieces and chew slowly. Dentures require that you chew your food for a longer period. The more time you take to eat, the faster you will master your denture. Place half of each forkful of food on the right side of your mouth, the other half on the left side in order to distribute the chewing pressure evenly. Chew slowly and chew "at" your food instead of "through" it. Try to relax and avoid chewing vigorously, as this may cause soreness. Don't attempt to eat an apple or corn on the cob immediately. Master the simpler things first. With time, you will become confident of your ability to eat normally, using common sense, of course, in the selection of your food. If you are having trouble with your dentures, give our office a call. You do not need a referral.
