

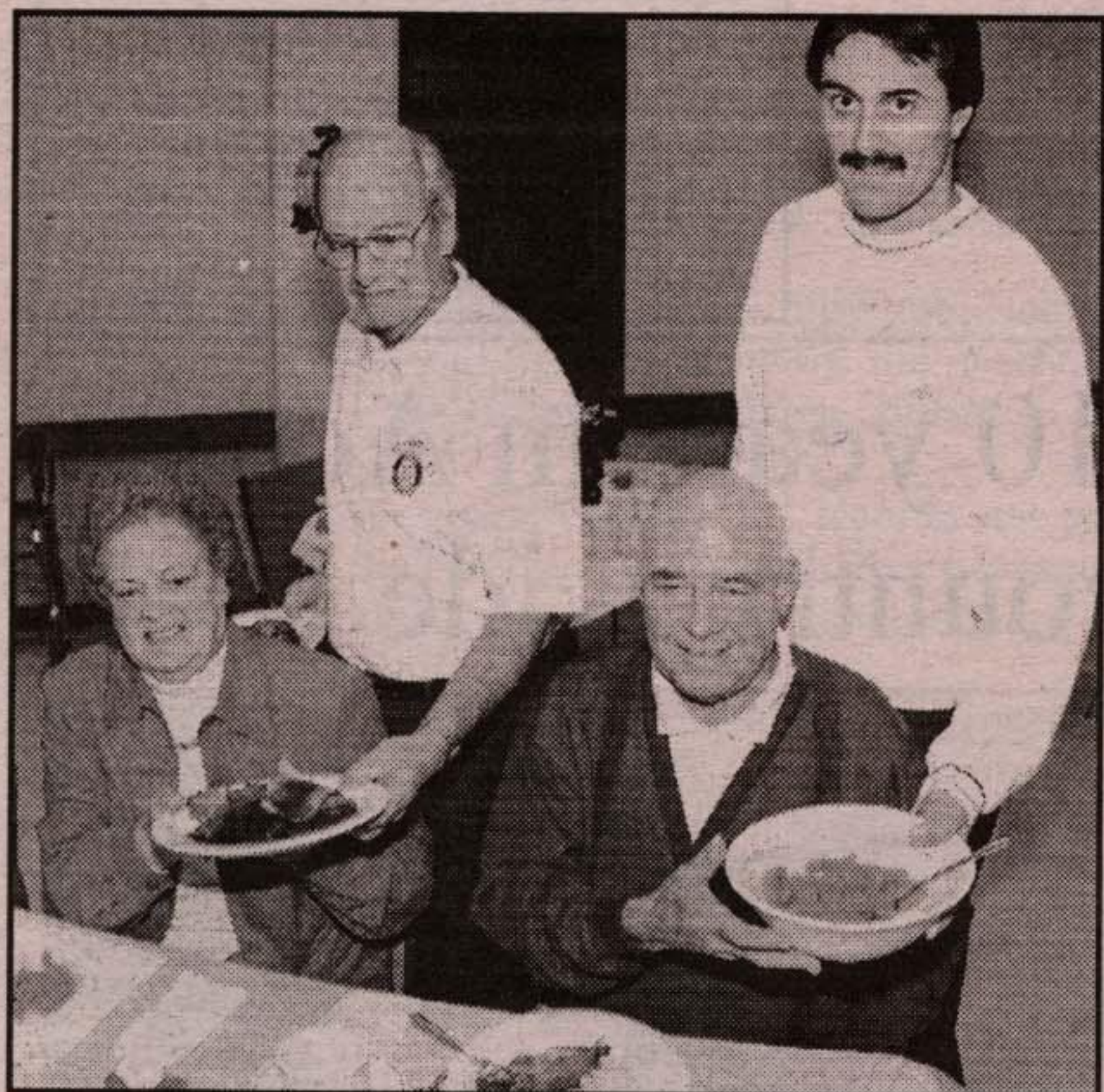
# Seniors move into expanded space

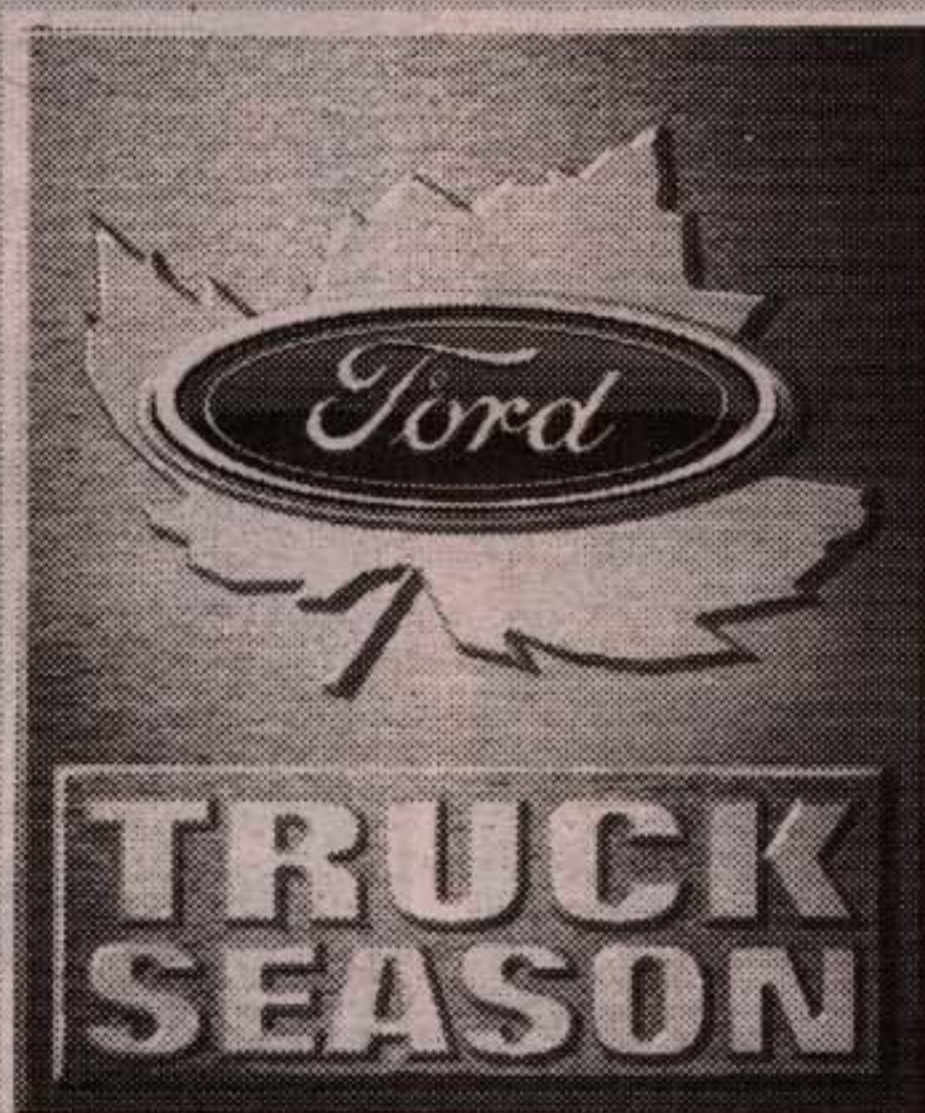
