Hospital amalgamation means new job for Trant

Dr. Don Trant has been named Vice-President Patient Programs and the Georgetown Hospital campus administrator for the Northwest GTA Hospital Corporation.

Trant, who for the past year served as the chief executive officer and chief of staff at the hospital and had been site administrator there since Georgetown, Peel Memorial and Etobicoke hospitals amalgamated in August, took over the new positions officially October 13.

Trant, a family doctor in town for about 20 years before he signed on to be hospital CEO for a year, has turned his practice over to Dr. Britt Carlson. He says he may do some clinical practice on a limited basis if possible.

Trant said leaving his practice was a tough decision. "I'll definitely miss the contact with my patients, some of them I've been looking after for 20 years," said Trant.

"I've been enjoying what I've done in the last year," said Trant. He said the opportunities to build the new organization are exciting.

As campus administrator Trant said he will be responsible for the functioning of the Georgetown campus.

As vice-president, Trant will be responsible for the organization and operations of the emergency systems, diagnostic imaging, laboratories, outpatient clinics and pharmacies, quality initiatives and some aspects of social work across the three sites in the corporation.

"I think there are some huge challenges and issues to deal with.

"I'm excited about the opportunities although there are some really significant financial pressures facing the hospital."

Region okays River Dr. changes

Halton Regional Council recently approved a number of changes on River Dr. in Georgetown. The speed limit, from Mountainview Rd. to 200 metres west of Tenth Line has been lowered to 50 km-h, increases to 60 km-h to 1,000 metres west of Winston Churchill Blvd. and then increases to 80 km-h.

A sign will be placed to warn trucks to avoid using engine brakes, and the intersection of River Dr. and Tenth Line will be converted to an all-way stop.
